

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(OXFORD, COWLEY MARSH AREA) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AND
WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (VARIATION No.4) ORDER 2023**

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45 & 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford, Cowley Marsh Area) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) (Variation No.4) Order 2023 and shall come into force on the 20th day of November 2023.
2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.

(2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include other genders and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.

(3) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed as a reference to a numbered Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
3. The Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford, Cowley Marsh Area) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) Order 2020, as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford, Cowley Marsh Area) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) (Variation No.1) Order 2021, the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford, Cowley Marsh Area) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) (Variation No.2) Order 2022, and the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford – Modification of Controlled Parking Zone Orders to enable online Applications for Virtual Parking Permits) Order 2022, ("the 2020 Order") is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Amendment to "the 2020 Order":

Amendments to the articles:

The below articles / article parts are deleted and replaced as follows:

(for Residents)

"Permit Formalities

24. A Residents' Permit or as applicable Temporary Permit will include the following particulars:

- (1) the registration number of the vehicle for which the Residents' Permit or as applicable Temporary Permit has been issued;
- (2) the period during which, subject to the provisions of Article 26 of this Order, the Residents' Permit or as applicable Temporary Permit will remain valid;
- (3) (an indication that the Residents' Permit or as applicable Temporary Permit has been issued by the Council; and
- (4) the zonal designation CM, or
- (5) the zonal designation RH."

(for Visitors)

"Permit Formalities

31. (1) Visitor's Permits will include the following particulars:

- (a) an indication that the Visitor's Permits have been issued by the Council; and
- (b) the zonal designation CM, or
- (c) the zonal designation RH

and may specify the period during which, subject to the provisions of Article 32, the Visitor's Permits may be used."

(for Business)

"Permit Formalities

37. A Business Permit will include the following particulars:

- (1) the registration number of the vehicle for which the Business Permit has been issued;
- (2) the period during which, subject always to the provisions of Article 38, the Business Permit remains valid;
- (3) an indication that the Business Permit has been issued by the Council;
- (4) the zonal designation CM, or
- (5) the zonal designation RH."

(for Hotels)

"Permit Formalities

43. (1) Each Hotel Visitor's Permit will include the following particulars:
- (i) An indication that the Hotel Visitor's Permit has been issued by the Council,
 - (ii) the zonal designation CM, or
 - (iii) the zonal designation RH."
