

**THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(WEST OXFORD AND OSNEY MEAD) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AND  
WAITING RESTRICTIONS) (CONSOLIDATION) (VARIATION No.14) ORDER 2023**

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35, 45, 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as The Oxfordshire County Council (West Oxford and Osney Mead) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) Consolidation (Variation No.14) Order 2023 and shall come into force on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of November 2023.
2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.  
  
(2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa.  
  
(3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.  
  
(4) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the numbered Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

  - (d) South side from a point 8 metres east of the eastern highway boundary of Abbey Road, eastwards for a distance of 10 metres.
5. Cripsey Road
- (a) West side; from a point 10 metres south of the southern property boundary of number 1 Cripsey Road, southwards for a distance of 10 metres.
  - (b) East side; from a point opposite the common property boundary of numbers 1/2 Cripsey Road, northwards for a distance of 50 metres.
  - (c) East side; from a point 12 metres north of a point opposite the northern highway boundary of Cripsey Place, northwards for a distance of 29 metres.
6. Duke Street East side; from a point 10 metres south of the southern highway boundary of Botley Road, southwards for a distance of 10 metres.
7. East Street
- (a) East side; from a point 16 metres south of a point opposite the southern highway boundary of North Street, southwards for a distance of 17 metres.

- (b) East side; from a point 24 metres south of a point opposite the common property boundary of number 27/28 East Street, southwards for a distance of 16 metres.
8. North Street
- (a) South side from a point 19.5 metres east of the eastern property boundary of number 2 North Street, eastwards for a distance of 4.5 metres.
- (b) North side from a point 41 metres east of the eastern highway boundary of Bridge Street, eastwards for a distance of 4.5 metres.
9. Osney Lane (East) South side; from the kerb at the eastern end of Osney Lane (East), westwards for a distance of 45 metres.
10. Riverside Road West side; from a point 8 metres south of the southern highway boundary of Botley Road, southwards for a distance of 13 metres.
11. Russell Street South side from a point 7 metres west of the western highway boundary of Mill Street, westwards for a distance of 20 metres.
