# THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SUMMERTOWN) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AND VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS) (VARIATION No.1) ORDER 2023 

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(2), 4(2), 32, 35 \& 45 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Summertown) (Controlled Parking Zone and Various Restrictions) (Variation No.1) Order 2023 and shall come into force on the $13^{\text {th }}$ day of November 2023.
2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment
(2) Words importing the masculine gender shall also include the feminine gender and words in the singular include the plural and vice versa
(3) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment
3. The Oxfordshire County Council (Summertown) (Controlled Parking Zone and Various Restrictions) Order 2023 is amended ("the 2023 CPZ Order") is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the Schedule to this Order.
