### OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (OXFORD, IFFLEY) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AND WAITING RESTRICTIONS)(VARIATON No.2) ORDER 2025

Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) & (2), 32, 35, 45 & 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford, Iffley) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) Order) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) (Variation No.2) Order 2025 and shall come into force on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June 2025.
- 2. (1) Any reference in this Order to any enactment (meaning any act and any subordinate legislation as defined in the Interpretation Act 1978) shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or replaced by any subsequent enactment.
  (2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.

(3) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall unless the context otherwise requires be construed as a reference to the numbered Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

 The Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford, Iffley) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) Order 2025, as amended by the Oxfordshire County Council (Oxford, Iffley) (Controlled Parking Zone and Waiting Restrictions) (Variation No.1) Order 2025 ("the 2025 Order") is amended in the manner and to the extent specified in the schedule to this order.

## 2.)

The below definitions are deleted and replaced as follows:

"Business Permit" means a permit issued by the Council to a Business under the provisions of Part VII of this Order to park, subject to the provisions of this Order, a Permitted Vehicle in respect of which the permit has been issued in the Parking Places specified in Schedules 4 and 5;"

"Hotel Visitor's Permit" means a permit issued by the Council to a hotel or guesthouse under the provisions of Part VIII of this Order to park a Permitted Vehicle, subject to the provisions of this Order, in the Parking Places specified in Schedules 4 and 5;"

#### "Prescribed Hours" means:

(1) in respect of parking places specified in Schedule 4, from 8.00am to 6:30pm all days;

(2) in respect of parking places specified in Schedule 5, from 8.00am to 6:30pm All Days;"

"**Street Trading Consent**" means a street trading licence issued pursuant to Schedules 4 and 5 to the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982;"

# 3.)

The below numbered articles are deleted and replaced as follows:

## "Designation of Parking Places

- 14. Each of the lengths of road specified in Schedules 4 and 5 to this Order, excluding;
  - (1) any Restricted Road
  - (2) any parts which may reasonably be used by a vehicle to get to or from any road;
  - (3) any Access Way; and
  - (4) any Controlled Length

is authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of Part III and IV of this Order, as a parking place for vehicles."

- 16." Save as provided in Articles 10 and 11 (Exemptions) or unless there is compliance with Article18 (Permit Parking) no person is to cause or permit any vehicle other than a Motor Cycle to wait in any Parking Place during the Prescribed Hours, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer, the Council or a police constable in uniform:
  - (1) in the roads specified in Part A of Schedule 4 and in Schedule 5 (during the relevant period of Prescribed Hours) for a period longer than 2 hours; or
  - (2) in the roads specified in Part B of Schedule 4 (during the relevant period of Prescribed Hours) for a period longer than 3 hours; or

if a period of less than 2 hours has elapsed since the termination during the Prescribed Hours of the last period of parking of the vehicle in the same Parking Place."

A new Schedule 5 is added to the order as follows:

## "SCHEDULE 5

# FOUR HOUR PARKING PLACES 8.00am to 6.30pm ALL DAYS NO RETURN WITHIN 2 HOURS

Church Way	East side	from a point opposite the northern kerb line of Mill Lane, northwards	for a distance of 20 metres
Mill Lane	South side	from a point 3 metres west of the eastern/front property boundary of No. 122 Church Way, eastwards	for a distance of 10 metres."
