PEMBROKESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2011 (VARIATION NO.1) ORDER 2011

The Pembrokeshire County Council ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46,49, 53, 101, 102, 124 and part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended, the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers of the Act and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the 26th day of August 2011 and may be cited as the Pembrokeshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (Variation No. 1) Order 2011.
- 2. The Pembrokeshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2011 ("the Consolidation Order") and schedules contained therein ("the Schedules") are hereby varied and shall have effect as though:-
- a) in Schedule 2.1 thereto there were inserted so as to maintain all items therein in alphabetical order of places and names of roads the following additional items: –

Fishguard

Clive Road

west side -

From a point 5 metres south of the junction with Vergam Terrace to

the lane adjacent to No.6, a length of 48 metres.

east side -

From a point 5 metres south of the junction with West Street

southwards for 5 metres

The Slade

both sides -

From the junction with West Street eastwards for 15 metres

b) in Schedule 8.3 thereto there were substituted for the description relating to **Tenby – St Johns**Hill, north side the following description –

north side -

From the boundary of No.6/7 St Johns Hill westwards for 25 metres.

From the boundary of No.5/6 The Green eastwards for 40 metres
