

THE PEMBROKESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2011
(VARIATION ORDER NO. 5 2016)

Pembrokeshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 32(1) and 35(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers of the Act and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of February 2016 and may be cited as The Pembrokeshire County Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (Variation Order No.5).

The Schedule ("the Schedule") to the Pembrokeshire County Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011 which came into operation on the 1st day of February 2011 shall be varied as follows:-

1. To introduce charges in Column 7 of the Schedule at parking places numbered 5,16,23,25,29,54 and 75
2. To introduce 'Parking Passport Permit' in Column 7 of the Schedule at parking places numbered 5,16,25,29,54 and 75
3. To introduce 'Resident Permits' in Column 7 of the Schedule at parking places numbered 16,25,29,54 and 75
4. To introduce 'Guardian Permits' in Column 7 of the Schedule at parking place numbered 75
5. To introduce 'Pop & Shop' free bays in Column 7 of the Schedule at parking places 29 and 75
6. To add the word 'Permit Holders' in Column 6 of the Schedule at parking places numbered 5,16,23,25,29,54 and 75
7. To introduce a new class of vehicle in Column 4 of the Schedule at parking place numbered 75
8. To introduce 'Seasonal Period' and 'Winter Period' in Column 5 of the Schedule at parking places numbered 5, 25, 29 and 54
9. To introduce 'Seasonal Period' in Column 5 of the Schedule at parking place numbered 16 and 75

Parking Definitions:

Seasonal Period – 1st March to 31st October 0900 hours – 1900 hours

Winter Period – 1st November to 29th February 0900 hours – 1700 hours

Parking Passport Permit – A weekly permit, purchased in advance. This will be a transferable permit which will allow parking in Council car parks, with some short stay car parks excluded. This is a flexible permit which will allow the purchaser the flexibility to purchase a single permit for multiple car parks, predominantly for visitors.

'Pop & Shop' bays – Free 30 minute bays. The number of bays will be 6% of the total car park bays for the specified car park, up to a maximum of six bays per car park; 1 of these bays will be for Blue Badge holders (Blue Badge bay will be 1hr free to allow more time for the Blue Badge holder).

Guardian Permit – Annual permit, purchased in advance to allow guardians to park in specified car parks for drop off and pick up of school children. The permit will specify school name and car park and will be allowable for parking between 9.00am and 9.30am; 2.30pm to 4.00pm, Monday to Friday, term time only. Permits will only be granted to guardians with children in school. The specified car parks are listed in the car park Order.

Eligibility for a Resident Permit - in Parking Places 16, 25, 29, 54 and 75 shall be limited to the following category:-

- Residents residing at the following properties.
- Applicant's residence does not have off-street parking available.
- Applicant does not have on-street parking available within close proximity of residence.
- One permit will be issued per property.
- The permit will be generic to a specific property.

- a) Business premises located at Quay Street, Haverfordwest
- b) One permit will be issued per Business.
- c) The permit will be generic to a specific Business.
