PEMBROKESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2011 (VARIATION NO.11) ORDER 2017

The Pembrokeshire County Council ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46,49, 53, 101, 102, 124 and part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended, the provisions of the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers of the Act and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on the 4th day of April 2017 and may be cited as the 'Pembrokeshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (Variation No.11) Order 2017'.
- 2. The Pembrokeshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011 ("the Consolidation Order") including the schedules contained therein is hereby varied and amended and shall have effect as though:-
- a) In Schedule 8 for article 8.3.8.3 Culver Park east side paragraphs a) & b), there was substituted:-

Culver Park

east side—from a point 10 metres south of the junction with Trafalgar Road, south for 65 metres.

b) In Schedule 8 article 8.3.8.3 Culver Park – west side is deleted.

c) In Schedule 8 the following is inserted: 8.6 Shared Use Bay (8am - 6pm Permit Holders or Limited waiting 2 hours no return within 1 hour / 6pm - 8am Permit holders only)

Those lengths of road contained in "the Consolidation Order" including the schedules therein and subsequent variations are hereby revoked where specifically mentioned or where the amendment as contained in this Order provides a new definition of the restriction to apply to that section of highway.
