THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 1988

(1) The Council of the City of Plymouth (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and all other powers enabling them in that behalf have made the Off Street Parking Places Orders listed in the First Schedule to this Order (hereinafter referred to as "the First Schedule Orders")

(2) It appears to the Council that there is advantage in rescinding the First Schedule Orders subject to certain saving provisions and consolidating and revising the First Schedule Orders in the present Order

(3) The Council in exercise of its powers under Section 35(1) and (3) of the 1984 Act and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act and of all other enabling powers with the consent of the Devon County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act now makes an Order in the following terms:-

Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on the First day of May One thousand nine hundred and eighty eight and may be cited as "The City of Plymouth (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1988

Interpretation

2. (1) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order and reference in this Order to a numbered Schedule is except where the context otherwise requires a reference to the Schedule bearing that number in this Order

(2) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-
"the Council" means the Council of the City of Plymouth

"Driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place

"Owner" in relation to a vehicle means the person by whom such vehicle is kept or used

"Parking Bay" means any area of a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle and indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place

"Parking place" means any area of land specified by name in Column 1 of Schedule 2 of this Order provided by the Council under Section 32 of the 1984 Act for use as an off street parking place

"Relevant position" means in relation to Article 22 of this Order

(a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen on the nearside of and immediately behind the windscreen so as to render the front of any badge displayed clearly visible from outside the vehicle or

(b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen any conspicuous position on the vehicle

(3) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament

Use of Area as Parking Place

3. Each area of land specified by name in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order may on any day be used (except in the case of the Civic Centre car park which may be used on Saturdays only) subject to the following provisions of this Order as a parking place for such classes of vehicle in such positions as are specified in relation to that area in the said Schedule subject to the payment of such charges on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that area in the said Schedule

Class of Vehicle

4. Where in Schedule 2 to this Order any parking place is described as being for vehicles of a specified class only the driver of a vehicle shall not

permit it to wait in that parking place unless it is of the class specified
Parking Spaces for Disabled Persons

5. Where within a parking place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a disabled persons vehicle or of some other specified class of vehicle the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking bay unless it is a disabled persons vehicle or is of such other class of vehicle as may be specified

Charges

6. In so far as a vehicle is left in a parking place during the charging hours the driver thereof shall pay such charge or charges as are specified in the following provisions of this Order

Amount of Charge at Parking Place

7. (1) The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall on leaving the vehicle in the parking place pay the appropriate charge in accordance with the scale of charges specified in Column 7 of Schedule 2 to this Order

(2) The Charges referred to in the last preceding paragraph and specified in Column 7 of the Schedule 2 to this Order shall be payable by the insertion of an appropriate coin or coins into the apparatus or device provided being an apparatus or device having been specifically or generally approved for such purpose in accordance with Section 35(3) of the 1984 Act and the provisions of Section 47(5) of the 1984 Act shall apply in respect of such apparatus

(3) Any ticket issued on payment of the charge referred to in Paragraph (1) of this Article, will indicate either payment of the charge and the date of issue or the date and time of issue and the period running from that time during which parking is permitted or the date and time at which the parking period expires and such ticket shall be attached to the vehicle in respect of which it was issued:-

(a) in the case of a motor cycle combination in a conspicuous position on the vehicle in front of the driving seat and

(b) in the case of all other vehicles:

- (i) where the vehicle is fitted with a transparent windscreen facing forwards on the inside surface of the windscreen so that it can be easily seen from the front of the vehicle
- (ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a transparent windscreen on the nearside of the vehicle in a conspicuous position

(4) The owner of a vehicle may on application to the Council purchase a season ticket in respect of that vehicle for a charge ascertained by reference to the scale of charges specified in Column 7 of Schedule 2 and that season ticket shall be valid only in the parking places specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 as long term parking places during the period for which it is issued provided it is attached to the vehicle in the manner specified in sub-paragraph (3) above

(5) Any ticket issued on payment of the charge referred to in Paragraph 1 of this Article in respect of the parking places specified in Schedule 2 of this Order shall be valid for the duration of the period purchased by the parking ticket or tickets in any parking place of the same designation that is to say if issued at a parking place specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 of this Order as a long term parking place in any other parking place so specified therein and if issued at a parking place specified in Column 1 of the said Schedule as a short term parking place in any other parking place so specified therein

(6) a vehicle shall not be left in a parking place if it displays an out of date ticket

Notice of Excess Charge

8. Where (1) any vehicle is left in a parking place for longer than the period paid for or (2) following the parking of a vehicle on arrival at a parking place the driver has (a) failed to pay the initial charge or (b) has failed to attach the ticket issued on payment of the charge referred to in

Paragraph 1 of Article 7 or the season ticket referred to in Paragraph 4 of Article 7 during the charging hours/an excess charge in the sum specified in the Third Schedule hereto shall become due in respect of each period for which a parking ticket is required and a notice shall be attached to the vehicle in a conspicuous position which shall include the following particulars:-

- (a) the registration mark of a vehicle or where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence the number of the trade plate carried by the vehicle
- (b) the time at which it was noticed that the excess charge had been incurred
- (c) a statement that the excess charge is required to be paid
- (d) the manner in which and time within which the excess charge should be paid and
- (e) a statement that it is an offence under this Order and Section 35(4) of the 1984 Act for the driver of a vehicle who has left the vehicle in a parking place to fail duly to pay the excess charge

Manner of Payment of Excess Charge

9. The driver of a vehicle in respect of which the excess charge has been incurred shall pay the excess charge to the Council either by cheque bankers draft money order or postal order which shall be delivered or sent by post so as to reach the City Treasurers Department of the Council at the City Treasury not later than 4.30 p.m. on the Fourteenth day following the day on which the excess charge was incurred or in cash in person at the said department not later than as aforesaid Provided that if the said Fourteenth day falls upon a day on which the said department is closed the period within which payment of the said charge shall be made to the Council shall be extended until 4.30 p.m. on the next full day on which the said department is open

Restriction on Removal of Notices and Tickets

10. (1) Where a notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the

provisions of Article 8 of this Order no person not being a parking attendant or some other person duly authorised by the Council shall remove the notice from the vehicle until the vehicle is removed from the parking place

(2) When a parking ticket or a season ticket has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order no person shall remove the parking ticket or the season ticket from the vehicle until the vehicle has been removed from the parking place

Engines

11. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place

Sale of Goods etc

12. (1) No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services

(2) No person shall within a parking place tout for custom or attempt to sell or offer for hire articles skills or services whether with or without a vehicle

Licensing and Insurance

13. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to wait in a parking place unless the vehicle is licensed in pursuance of the provisions of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971 and unless there is in relation to the use of the vehicle by the driver such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of Part IV of the Road Traffic Act 1972

Sounding of Horns

14. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall not sound any horn or similar instrument except when about to change the position of the

vehicle in or depart from that parking place

Driving in Parking Places

15. No person shall except with the permission of the Council drive or permit to be driven any vehicle in a parking place for any purpose other than the purpose of leaving that vehicle in that parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from that parking place

Disturbance

16. No person shall in any parking place wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of a parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood

Behaviour in Parking Places

17. No person shall in a parking place use any threatening abusive or insulting language gesture or conduct so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned

Use of Vehicles in Parking Places

18. (1) No person shall use any part of a parking place or any vehicle left in a parking place -

- (a) for sleeping or camping or
- (b) for cooking or
- (c) for the purpose of repairing servicing washing painting or otherwise tending any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from that parking place in a roadworthy condition

(2) No person shall drive any vehicle in any parking place unless he or she shall be the holder of a current drivers licence for that class of vehicle within the meaning of Section 84 of the Road Traffic Act 1972

19. No person shall use a parking place as a means of passage of a vehicle proceeding from one road to another road

Signs and Directions

20. (1) Where in a parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:-

- (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from that parking place or
- (b) indicating that a vehicle using that parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place

no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle (i) so that it enters that parking place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves that parking place otherwise than by an exit so indicated or (ii) in a direction other than so specified

(2) Where in a parking place surface markings are laid indicating parking bays for individual vehicles no vehicle should be parked in such a parking place except within such a parking bay and no vehicle shall be parked so as to cause an obstruction to other vehicles entering or leaving a parking place or any parking bay therein

Prohibitions

21. In a parking place no person shall -

- (a) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent booth stand building or other structure without the written consent of the Council
- (b) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire
- (c) abandon or cause to be abandoned any shopping trolley save in a bay designated for that purpose where provided

Exemptions from Charges

22. The following vehicles left in a parking place shall be exempt from any limitation on time and from the payment of any charge specified in Schedule 2 of this Order and from the payment of any excess charge

- (1) An invalid carriage
- (2) A vehicle issued to a disabled person by the Department of Health and Social Security in lieu of an invalid carriage

(3) A vehicle left by the driver thereof who is a person who on account of his severe physical disability has been given a notice in writing by the Council that he is exempt from any such charge or limitation on time if the notice is displayed on the vehicle in a conspicuous position

(4) A disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge issued by any local authority in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982 or a badge having effect under those regulations as if it were a disabled persons badge

(5) A motor cycle without sidecar

(6) A bicycle

Closure of Parking Places

23. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Order the Council may by a written notice displayed on or near a parking place close that parking place or any part thereof for any period and no driver of any vehicle shall use that parking place or any part thereof when it is so closed

Indications by Ticket Issuing Machines and Tickets as Evidence

24. If during charging hours a vehicle is left in a parking place and has displayed on it a ticket or tickets issued by a ticket issuing machine the time indicated on the ticket issuing machine clock shall be admissible as evidence as to whether or not the period has expired for which the initial charge shown on such ticket or tickets was paid and in any proceedings for an offence under Section 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 of failing to pay the excess charge shall also be admissible as evidence as to whether or not an excess charge was incurred

Duty to Give Information as to Identity of Driver

25. (1) Where the driver of a vehicle is alleged to be guilty of an offence under this Order the owner of the vehicle shall give such information as to the identity of the driver as he may be required to give by or on behalf of

the Council and

(2) Any other person shall if required as aforesaid give information it is in his power to give which may lead to the identification of the driver

Incorporation of Section 47 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

26. The provisions of Section 47 of the 1984 Act shall apply to a parking place as if it were a designated parking place provided on a highway

Removal and disposal of Vehicles

27. (1) If a vehicle is left in a parking place in a position other than in accordance with the provisions of this Order a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle so that its position is in accordance with the said provisions

(2) If a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the foregoing provisions of this Order a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may remove the vehicle from that parking place or arrange for such removal

(3) Any Police Constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a parking place or remove or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place

(4) Any person altering or causing the alteration of the position of a vehicle by virtue of paragraph (1) of this Article or removing or causing the removal of a vehicle by virtue of paragraph (2) or (3) of this Article may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think reasonably necessary to enable the position of the vehicle to be altered or the vehicle to be removed

(5) Any person removing or arranging for the removal of a vehicle by virtue of paragraphs (2) or (3) of this Article shall make such arrangements as he considers to be reasonably necessary for the safety of the vehicle in the place to which it is removed

Revocation of Existing Orders

28. The Orders listed in Schedule 1 to this Order are hereby revoked save in so far as the same would affect proceedings started or notices served prior to the date on which this Order became operative

THE THIRD SCHEDULE

(EXCESS CHARGE)

The Excess Charge is Twenty five pounds (£25.00) from the date of commencement of this Order until the Second day of April One thousand nine hundred and eighty nine and thereafter is Thirty pounds (£30.00) provided that in the event of such excess charge on becoming due being paid to the Council within fourteen days of it being incurred such payment to be made in accordance with the provisions of Article 9 then the Council agrees to accept in full satisfaction of payment of such excess charge the sums of Twelve pounds and fifty pence (£12.50) and Fifteen pounds (£15.00) respectively in lieu of the aforesaid sums of Twenty five pounds (£25.00) and Thirty pounds (£30.00)


