THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) AMENDMENT ORDER (NUMBER 1), 1989

The Plymouth City Council in exercise of their powers under Part IV and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "The 1984 Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf after consultation with the Chief Constable of the Devon and Cornwall Constabulary in accordance with the said Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act and the Devon County Council in accordance with Regulation 4 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) Regulations 1986 HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

Commencement and Citation

 This Order shall come into operation on the Fourth day of December 1989 and may be cited as "The City of Plymouth (Off-Street Parking Places)
 Amendment Order (Number 1) 1989"

Interpretation

- 2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the expression "The Principal Order" means "The City of Plymouth (Off-Street Parking Places)
 Order 1988"
- 3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of Acts of Parliament

 Amendment of the Principal Order
- 4. The Principal Order shall be read as though Article 27 thereof incorporated the matters set out in the First Schedule hereto and as though the Second Schedule thereof incorporated the matters set out in the Second Schedule hereto

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SCHEDULE SHALL FORM SUB-ARTICLE 6 TO ARTICLE 27 OF THE PRINCIPAL ORDER:-

In addition to the foregoing provisions a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may in relation to any vehicle left in a parking place in a position other than in accordance with the provisions of this Order immobilize such vehicle by means of a wheel clamping device and shall make such arrangements as he considers to be reasonably necessary for the release of that device which arrangements shall include the prior recovery by the Council of its reasonable costs of so doing
