(NUMBER 4) 1991

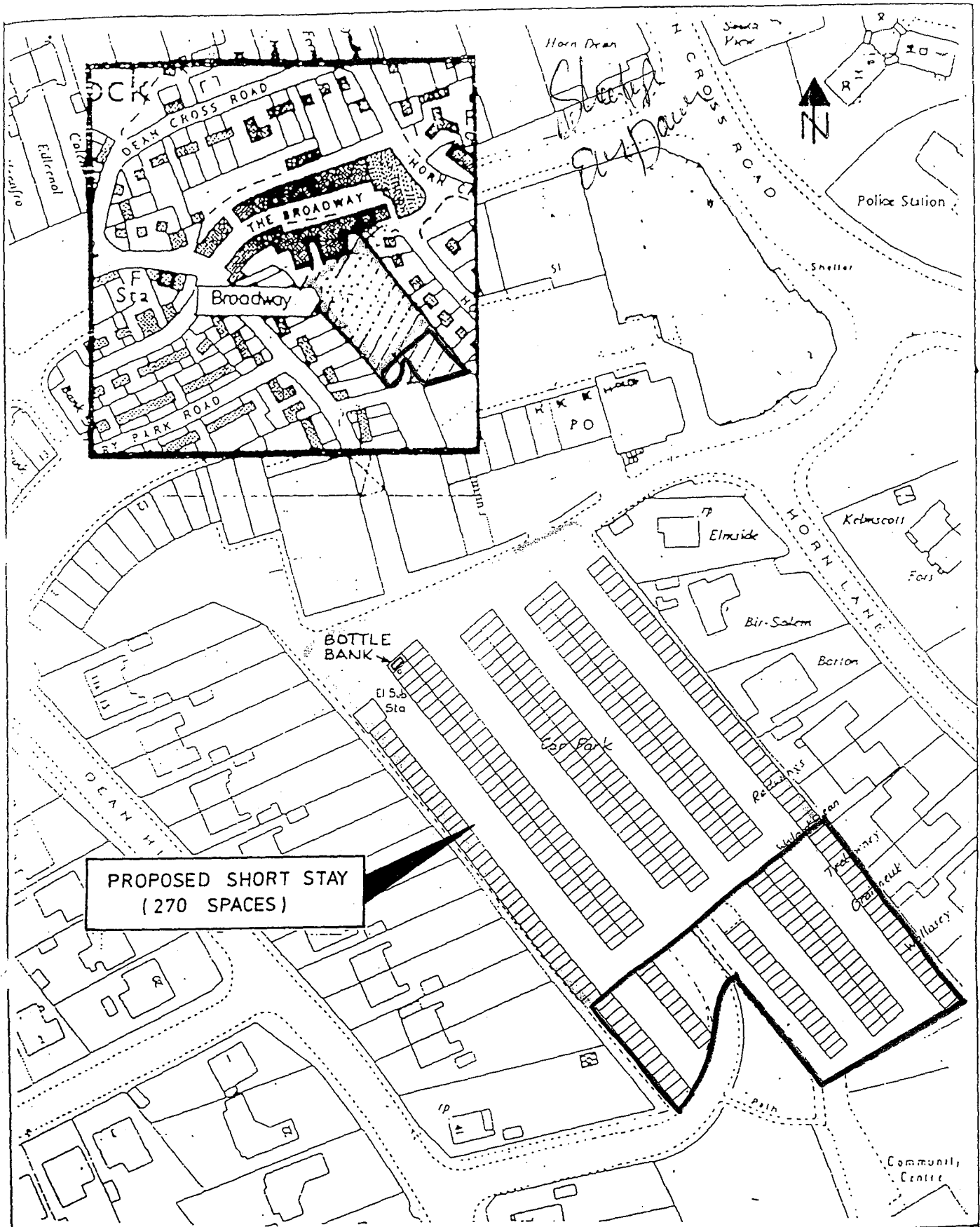
The Council of the City of Plymouth in exercise of their powers under Section 35 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "The 1984 Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf after consultation with the Chief Constable of the Devon and Cornwall Constabulary in accordance with Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER

Commencement and Citation

1. The Order shall come into operation the 4th day of February 1991 and shall be cited as "The City of Plymouth (Off Street Parking Places) Amendment Order (Number 4)"
2. In this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the expression "The Principal Order" means The City of Plymouth (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1988

AMENDMENT TO THE PRINCIPAL ORDER

4. The Principal Order shall read as though the First Schedule thereof incorporated the matters set out in the Schedule hereto

PROPOSED SHORT STAY SPACES — PLYMSTOCK BROADWAY


