- 3. In this Order accept where the context otherwise requires it "the Principal Order" means the City of Plymouth (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1988 as amended by the City of Plymouth (Off-Street Parking Places) Amendment Order Nos. 1-7.
- 4. The Interpretation Act of 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of Acts of Parliament.
