**THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH
(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) AMENDMENT ORDER (NO.9) 1994**

1. The Council of the City of Plymouth (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 35, Part IV and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the 1984 Act) and all other enduring powers in that behalf and with the consent of Devon County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act and in accordance with the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1989 HEREBY MAKES AN ORDER IN THE FOLLOWING TERMS:-

COMMENCEMENT AND CITATIONS

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 13th day of February one thousand nine hundred and ninety five and shall be cited as "The City of Plymouth (Off Street Parking Places) Amendment Order (No.9) 1994.

INTERPRETATION

3. The Interpretation Act of 1978 or any statutory re-enactment thereof shall apply to the interpretation of this Order and applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. In this Order except where the conditions within the existing parking order, being The City of Plymouth (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1988 as amended by the City of Plymouth (Off Street Parking Places) Amendment Order (Nos 1-8)) are inconsistent the same conditions therein will apply.
5. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the expression "The Principal Order" means "The City of Plymouth (Off Street Parking Places) Amendment Order (No.7) 1993".

AMENDMENT TO THE PRINCIPAL ORDER

6. The Principal Order shall be amended insofar as it relates only to Exchange Street Car Park in that Schedule 9 reads as follows :

Name of the Car Park

Scale of Charges

Exchange Street

0 - 1/2 hour £0.25
1/2 - 1 hour £0.40
1 - 2 hours £0.80

EFFECT OF THE ORDER

7. This Order will re-designate the Exchange Street Car Park to a 2 hour maximum stay car park.
