

THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH
(AMENDMENT No. 2004.03B – PLYMBRIDGE LANE SOUTHERN SPUR)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
ORDER 2005

The Council of the City of Plymouth (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of their powers under the relevant Sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with the relevant sections of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

This Order may be cited as **The City of Plymouth (Amendment No. 2004.03B – Plymbridge Lane Southern Spur) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2005** and shall come into operation on the **25th April 2005**.

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of roads specified in **Schedule 1** to this Order.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in any of the length of road referred to in that Article if the motor vehicle is being used:
 - a) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to the length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in the length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction in the length of road, or the laying erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
 - b) in connection with Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes.
 - c) as a bus or a taxi.
3. Bus has the same meaning as in Regulation 22(2) of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions (TSRGD) and bus shall be construed accordingly.
4. Taxi means either a Hackney Carriage (ie the meaning as in the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and The Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976) or a Private Hire Vehicle (ie a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to seat fewer than eight passengers other than a hackney carriage or bus, which is provided for hire with the services of a driver for the purposes of carrying passengers).
