(AMENDMENT No 2004.03a)
ORDER 2004

The City of Plymouth in exercise of their powers under the relevant Parts, Sections and Schedules of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

The City Of Plymouth (Barnstaple Close, Leigham)(Weight Restriction) (Amendment No 2004.03a) Order 2004:

This shall have the effect to amend “The City of Plymouth (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places)(Consolidation) Order 2004 as follows:

The following Restrictions Types be added to the Articles to this Order in the appropriate sequence

PART M MOVING TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

Save as provided in part H to this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the roads specified for the length specified, if the maximum gross weight of that vehicle exceeds that specified in the various parts of the **Two Hundred and Eighth Schedule** to this Order as defined below.

- PART 1 Maximum Gross Weight 7.5 Tonnes** in any length of road specified in Part 1 of the Two Hundred and Eighth Schedule to this Order;
- PART 2 Maximum Gross Weight 7.5 Tonnes Except for Access** in any length of road specified in Part 2 of the Two Hundred and Eighth Schedule to this Order;
- PART 3 Maximum Gross Weight 18 Tonnes** in any length of road specified in Part 3 of the Two Hundred and Eighth Schedule to this Order;

The following be added to Part H Exemptions from Prohibitions and Restrictions in the appropriate sequence

WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

1) Nothing in PART 1, 2 or 3 of the Two Hundred and Eighth Schedule shall apply so as to prevent any persons from causing any goods vehicle to proceed in the lengths of roads specified in PARTS 1, 2 or 3 of the Two Hundred and Eighth Schedule if:

- a) the vehicle is being used in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road;
- b) the vehicle is being used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road;
- c) the vehicle is being used in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road;
- d) the vehicle is being used in connection with the maintenance of essential Local Authority Services, or laying, erecting, making alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic communications as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- e) the vehicle is being used in connection with Police, Fire and Rescue or Ambulance vehicles;
- f) the vehicle is a bus.

2) Nothing in PART 2 of the Two Hundred and Eighth Schedule shall apply so as to prevent any persons from causing any goods vehicle to proceed in the lengths of roads specified in PART 2 of the Two Hundred and Eighth Schedule if:

- a) The vehicle is being used for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the lengths of road.
