THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH (EXETER ST/BRETONSIDE JUNCTION) (PROHIBITION OF LEFT TURN) ORDER 2005

The Council of the City of Plymouth (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under the relevant Sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

This Order may be cited as The City of Plymouth (Exeter St./Bretonside Junction) (Prohibition of Left Turn) Order 2005, and shall come into operation on the **25th** day of April 2005.

This Order amends the City of Plymouth (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2004 and any relevant subsequently made Orders as follows:

- 1 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 1, to make a left turn into the road specified in column 2 of the said Schedule to this Order.
- 2 The items in Schedule 1 be added to Part 2 of the Two Hundred and Third Schedule of the City of Plymouth (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2004 and any relevant subsequently made Orders.
- 3 Nothing in this Order shall apply to:
 - a) any vehicle being used for fire/rescue service, ambulance or police purposes.
 - b) Local buses, having been granted approval by the police and the council, in association with necessary diversions in connection with special events occurring in the city centre.
