

**THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH
(GRENVILLE ROAD)
(ONE WAYS AND PROHIBITION OF TURNS AND ENTRY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2005.13a)
ORDER 2005**

The Council of the City of Plymouth (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under the relevant Sections, Parts and Schedules of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

CITATION AND REVOCATION

1. A) This Order shall come into force on the 2006 and may be cited as The City of Plymouth (Ridgeway, Grenville Road and North Hill)(Prohibition of Turns)(Amendment No. 2005.13) Order 2005.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any road specified in Column 1, for that length specified in Column 2 other than in the direction specified in Column 3 in Schedule 1 of this Order.
3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to:
 - a) Any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes if the observance of any provision of this order would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purposes for which it is being used on that occasion.
 - b) Anything done with the permission, or at the direction of a police officer or traffic warden in uniform.
 - c) Any pedal cycle
