## THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 2009.375118 – MADEIRA ROAD) ORDER 2009

The City of Plymouth in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NUMBER 375118 – MADEIRA) ORDER 2009

This shall have the effect of amending "The City of Plymouth (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2004" as follows:

1) Revoke the following from The City of Plymouth (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places)(Consolidation) Order 2004:

Schedule No. 1.1 (No Waiting At Any Time)

- (i) Madeira Road: the east side from the junction with The Barbican to a point 62 metres south of the junction with Lambhay Hill
- 2) Revoke the following from THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 2006.10 CITY CENTRE PAY AND DISPLAY) AMENDMENT ORDER 2006:

Schedule No. 4.02 (Pay And Display Maximum Stay 2 Hours No Return Within 1 Hour 8am-6pm)

- (i) Madeira Road, the west side from a point 38 metres east and north of its junction with Lambhay Hill for a distance of 118 metres in a northerly direction
- 3) Add the following to Schedule 1.1 (No Waiting At Any Time):
  - (i) Madeira Road, the west side from a point 38 metres east and north of its junction with Lambhay Hill for a distance of 118 metres in a northerly direction
  - (ii) Madeira Road, the east side from its junction with The Barbican for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction
  - (iii) Madeira Road, the east side from a point 76 metres south of its junction with The Barbican for a distance of 119 metres in a southerly direction
- 4) Add the following to Schedule 4.02 (Pay And Display Maximum Stay 2 Hours No Return Within 1 Hour 8am-6pm):
  - (i) Madeira Road, the east side from a point 22 metres south of its junction with The Barbican for a distance of 54 metres in a southerly direction
- 5) Add the following to Schedule 5.10 (Bus Parking Places):

(i) Madeira Road, the east side from a point 15 metres south of its junction with The Barbican for a distance of 34 metres in a southwesterly direction
