

**The City of Plymouth  
(Rear Lanes) (Prohibition of Traffic and Pedestrians)  
Order 2009**

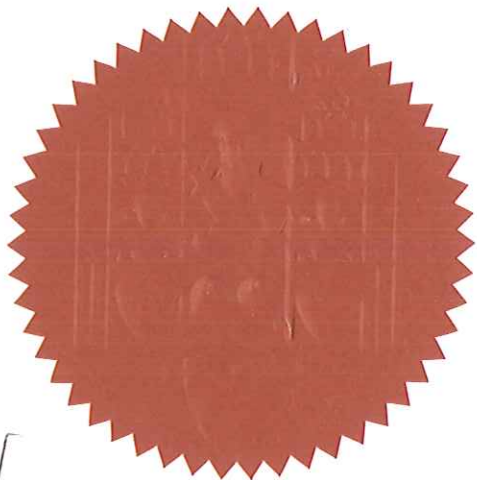
The City of Plymouth in exercise of their powers under the relevant Sections and Schedules of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the "Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

- (1) This Order shall come into operation on the       day of       and shall be cited as The City of Plymouth (Rear Lanes) (Prohibition of Traffic and Pedestrians) Order 2009
- (2) Save as provided in Article 3 below, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle or pedestrian to proceed over the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- (3) Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to the following:-
  - (a) ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes;
  - (b) any person being an owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of those premises adjoining or adjacent to the same length of rear lane as described in Schedule 1 of this Order or their visitors.
  - (c) Any vehicle or pedestrian proceeding over the said lengths of road, (if the vehicle cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road), in connection with;
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition works;
    - (ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of roads;
    - (iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or land adjacent to the said length of road, of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus and the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984
    - (iv) the service of a Local Authority for the collection of refuse from premises adjacent to the said length of road;
    - (v) any other service provided by the Local Authority.

**(Prohibition of all vehicles and pedestrians, with exemptions)**

**Yeomans Terrace Lane East** For its entire length (Between Tresluggan Road and Trelawney Avenue)
