#### 1.1 No Waiting At Any Time

- (i) James Street the west side, from a point 4 metres south of its junction with Mount Street for a distance of 42 metres in a northerly direction.
- (ii) James Street the west side, from its junction with Duke Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 11 metres.
- (iii) James Street the west side, 35 metres from its junction with Duke Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 17 metres.
- (iv) James Street the west side, from its junction with Duke Street for a distance of 73 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- (v) James Street the east side, from the extended kerbline of its junction with Duke Street for a distance of 18 metres in a north-easterly direction and 20 metres in a southerly direction.
- (vi) James Street the east side, from a point 31 metres south of the extended kerbline of its junction with Duke Street for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.
- (vii) Duke Street the north-east side from its junction with James Street for a distance of 13 metres in a north-westerly direction.
- (viii) Duke Street the south-west side from its junction with James Street for a distance of 18 metres in a north-westerly direction.
- (ix) Mount Street the south side, from a point on the western side of the build out, 18.2 metres from the junction with Pembroke Lane, in a westerly then southerly direction to its junction with James Street.
- (x) Mount Street the north side, from the east side of its junction with Bennett Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 30 metres.
- (xi) Mount Street the north side, from the west side of its junction with Bennett Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 52 metres.
- (xii) Bennett Street the east side from its junction with Mount Street for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.
- (xiii) Bennett Street the west side from its junction with Mount Street for a distance of 14 metres in a northerly direction.


