

**THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET

9.01 No Loading/Unloading At Any Time

- (i) Old George Street from its junction with Princess Way to its junction with Derry's Cross in a north easterly direction, then a north westerly direction and then a south westerly direction for a length of 91 metres.
- (ii) Princess Way, east side, from its junction with Athenaeum Place to its junction with Old George Street in a north westerly direction for a distance of 70 metres.
- (iii) Princess Way west side from its junction with Derry's Cross to its junction with Athenaeum Place in a south easterly direction for a length of 79 metres.
- (iv) Athenaeum Place from its junction with the Civic Centre car park to its junction with Princess Way in a south westerly direction for a length of 56 metres.
- (v) Derry's Cross from its junction with Princess Way in a south easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres.

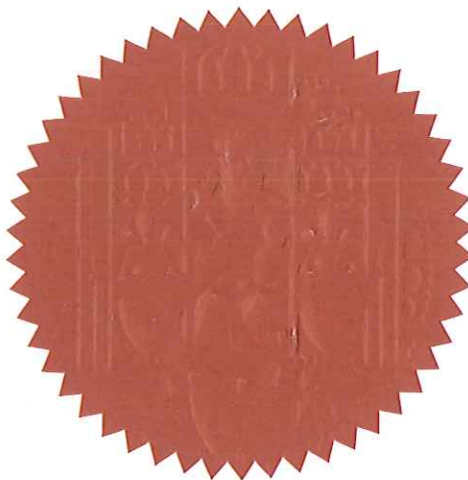
