

**THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH
(MOVING TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS)
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2011**

The Council of the City of Plymouth (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of their powers under the relevant Sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and the relevant Sections of the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

PART I - GENERAL

- 1 This order shall come into operation on 22nd of April 2011 and may be cited as The City of Plymouth (Moving Traffic Regulation Orders) (Consolidation) Order 2011.

3 Interpretation

In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"The Act of 1984" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended);

"The Act of 1991" means the Road Traffic Act 1991

"The Act of 2000" means The Transport Act 2000

"TSRGD" means the current Edition of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions;

"the Council" means the Plymouth City Council, as Traffic Authority;

"Approved device" means a device of a description specified in an Order made by the Relevant National Authority in line with Section 144 of the Act Of 2000 and adhering to The Bus Lane (Approved Devices) (England) Order 2005

"buses" has the same meaning as in Regulation 22(2) of the traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions (TSRGD) and bus shall be construed accordingly;

“Bus lane” means any area of the left or right hand lane or circulatory part of that length of carriageway, which is bounded on one side by a kerblin and on the other by a road marking complying with diagram no. 1049 in Schedule Six to the TSRGD and has the same meaning as in Regulation 23 of the TSRGD;

“carriageway” means the way constituting or comprised in a highway being a way (other than a cycle track) over which the public have the right of way for the passage of vehicles;

“Highway” is a way over which the public has the right to pass and repass;

"hackney carriage" has the same meaning as in the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and The Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

“local service” has the same meaning as the Transport Act 1985

~~“lay by” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994 and partly by the verge or outer edge of the carriageway;~~

~~“licensed taxi” has the same meaning as in Section 13(3)(a) of the Transport Act 1985;~~

~~“main carriageway” means any carriageway used primarily by through traffic, includes any carriageway of a slip road, but excludes any lay by;~~

"motor cycle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being an invalid carriage) with fewer than 4 wheels, of which the weight un-laden does not exceed 410 kilograms;

“owner”, in relation to any vehicle failing to comply with the regulations specified in this Order shall be that person or organisation to whom the said vehicle is registered with the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Centre;

“PCN” means a Penalty Charge Notice

“Pedal cycle” has the same meaning as in regulation 4 of the TSRGD

~~“permanent user” means that person who not being the legal owner of a vehicle is the normal driver and has responsibility for that vehicle;~~

~~“public service vehicle” has the same meaning as in the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;~~

~~“Private Hire Vehicle” means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to seat fewer than eight passengers other than a hackney carriage or bus which is provided for hire with the services of a driver for the purposes of carrying passengers~~

“Private Hire Vehicle” means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to seat fewer than eight passengers other than a hackney carriage or bus which is licenced and provided for hire with the services of a driver for the purposes of carrying passengers

"road" means any length of highway or of any other road to which the public has access, and includes bridges over which a road passes;

~~“restricted road” means any of the roads, lengths of road or sides of road specified in any of the Schedules to this Order;~~

“Restricted road” means any of the roads, lengths of road or sides of road identified in any of the Map Schedules to this Order

~~“specified road” means any road or length of road or side of road specified in the Schedules to this Order~~

“Specified road” means any road or length of road or side of road identified in the Map Schedules to this Order

“Taxi” means either a Hackney Carriage or a Private Hire Vehicle

“Traffic Officer” has the same meaning as the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under, section 64 of the Act of 1984;

(1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires:

- a) any reference to a numbered Article or a numbered Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order,
- b) any reference to a numbered or lettered paragraph or sub-paragraph is a reference to the paragraph or sub-paragraph bearing that number or letter in the Article or Schedule or (in the case of a sub-paragraph) paragraph in which the reference occurs, and
- ~~c) any reference to a Table, or to a numbered Table, is a reference to the Table, or to the Table bearing that number, in the Article or Schedule in which that reference occurs.~~

(2) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made under or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or by or under any other enactment;

(3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment;

(4) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

“Vehicle” includes any part of a vehicle

For the purpose of this Order the prohibitions and restrictions contained in the Articles to this Order and shown on the attached plans shall apply to the full extent of the public highway

A reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the Article of this order so numbered

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12 EXEMPTIONS

Nothing in Articles 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 of this Order shall; render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any road or length of road as identified in the plans attached to this order for so long as may be necessary to enable:

- a) The vehicle to comply with directions of with permission of a Police Constable or of a Traffic Officer;
- b) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, be used in the service of the Council in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- c) The vehicle be used in the service of the Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance Service;
- d) The vehicle be used in any case where the person in control of the vehicle
 - i) Is required by law to stop or wait or is permitted to stop or wait by a Police Constable in uniform;
 - ii) Is obliged to stop so as to prevent an accident, or
 - iii) Is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control

13 CIVIL ENFORCEMENT

The Council will carry out civil enforcement of any contravention of any prohibitions in the Fifth Schedule of the Order by permitting the imposition of a Penalty Charge only on the basis of a record

produced by the means of an 'Approved Device'.

- 14** Where the Council have reason to believe that a Penalty Charge is payable in relation to a vehicle which has contravened Article 5 of this Order the Council will serve a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) in accordance with The Bus Lane Contraventions (Penalty Charge, Adjudication and Enforcement)(England) Regulations 2005 on the person:

 - i) Appearing to be the owner or keeper of the vehicle or
 - ii) Appearing to be the person liable to pay the charge

- 15** If a vehicle owner, keeper or driver contravenes any prohibitions or restrictions of Article 5 of this Order, a charge set by the Council pursuant to Regulations under Section 144 (3) of the Act of 2000 and in accordance with guidance given by the Relevant National Authority (the Penalty Charge) is to be paid in the manner described in the notice within 28 days of the Date of Service of the PCN or within 14 days of the Date of Service of the PCN in the case of a reduced penalty charge.

- 16** When the owner, keeper or driver has been identified the Council will issue a PCN in accordance with this Order and send the PCN by post
