

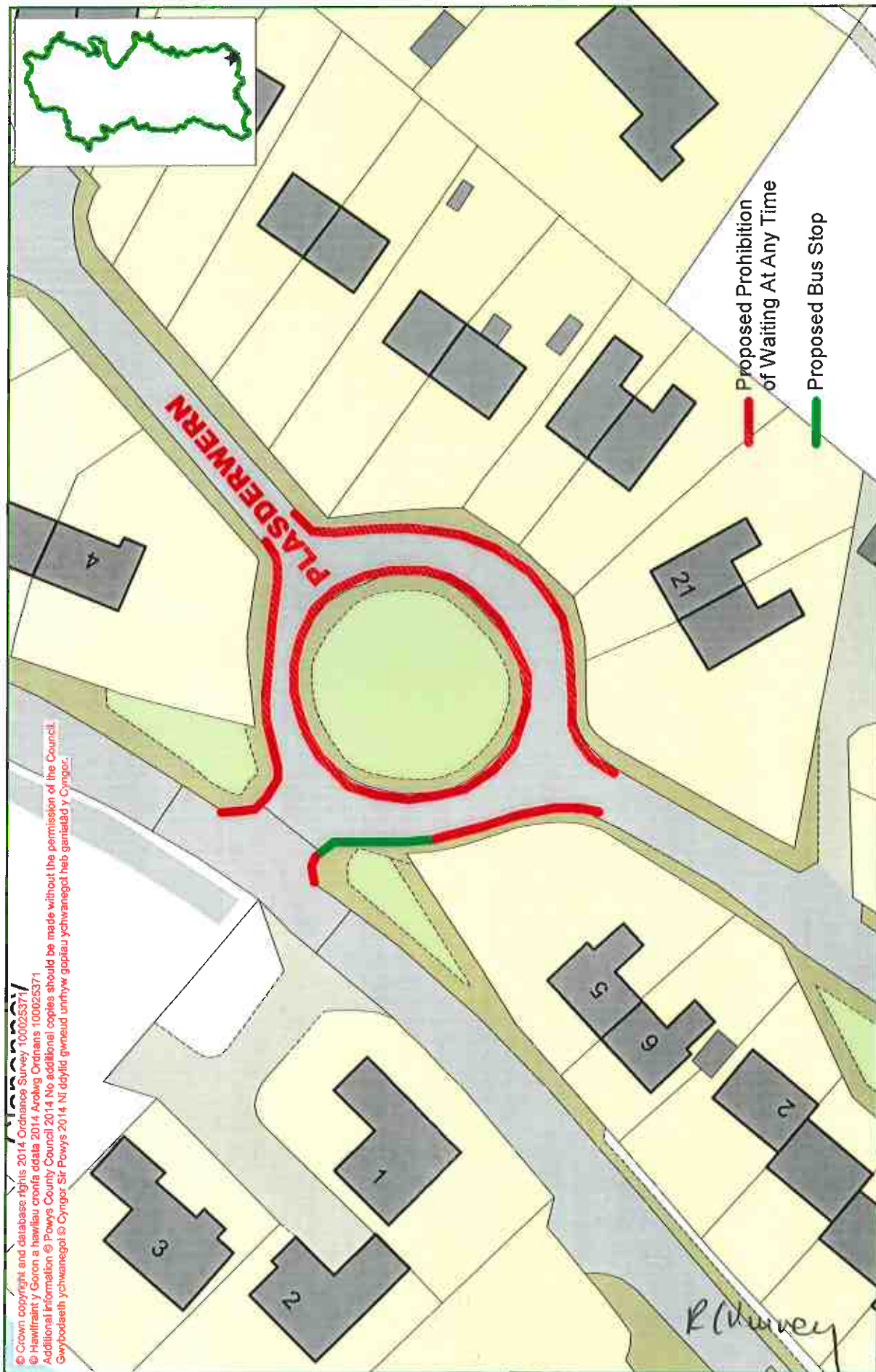
THE COUNTY OF POWYS
(PLASDERWERN LLANGATTOCK)(NO STOPPING EXCEPT BUSES) ORDER
2014

POWYS COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of July 2014 and may be cited as the County of Powys (Plasderwern Llangattock)(No Stopping Except Buses) Order 2014 .
2. In this Order:

 'bus stop' means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002; and subject to Regulation 29(1) of and the provisions of Part I of Schedule 19 to the said regulations and general directions.

 'public service vehicle' shall have the same meaning as in Part I: Section 1(1) of the public passenger Vehicles Act 1981.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any day along the side of the length of road which is designated an authorised bus stop and which is specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait along the side of the length of road which is designated an authorised bus stop and which is specified in the Schedule to this Order for so long as may be necessary.



Llangattock Parking Review

- (a) to enable the vehicle if it is in the service of or employed by the Post Office to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- (b) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition the removal of any obstruction to traffic the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the side of the length of road so specified or the laying erection alteration or repair in or near the said side of that length of road of any sewer or any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or any telegraphic line as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (c) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in the service of a local authority or a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and
- (d) to enable the vehicle to be used for fire brigade ambulance or police purposes.

5. The plan annexed hereto is for the purposes of identification only.

Plasderwern (County Classified Road Number U0582)
