## CITY OF PRESTON (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2009 AMENDMENT ORDER 2016

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Preston City Council made the above named Order under sections 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and in consideration of the provisions of the Road Traffic Act 1991, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and The Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (County of Lancashire) Order 2004 and all other enabling powers.

The Order was made on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2016 and will come into effect on 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2016

The effect of the Order is twofold -

- (i) it alters the structure of the times during which Hill Street Surface Car Park operates so that the overnight parking rate will apply between 6.30pm and 6.00am and –
- (ii) it alters the charging structure at the following car parks so as to remove from vehicles which display a disabled person's badge the exemptions from the requirements to pay a charge and to display a parking ticket which have hitherto applied in respect of those car parks and replaced them with a maximum period of three hours' free parking in designated disabled parking spaces for vehicles which display in the correct manner a valid disabled person's blue badge, with no return within eight hours
- Market Multi-Storey Cark Park
- Hill Street Surface Car Park

A copy of the Order, a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order and a copy of the City of Preston (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009 which the Order amends may be inspected at the Town Hall, Lancaster Road, Preston, Monday-Friday, 9.00.am to 5.00pm (except Thursday – 10.00am to 5.00 pm).

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that there has not been compliance with any requirement of the Act or any regulations made thereunder may within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made make an application for the purpose to the High Court.

Preston City Council in exercise of its power under sections 32 and 35 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and in consideration of the provisions of the Road Traffic Act 1991, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (County of Lancashire) Order 2004 and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the County Council of Lancashire in accordance with section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of the Schedule 9 to the 1984 hereby makes the following Order:

1. The Schedule to the City of Preston (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009 is hereby revoked and the following Schedule is incorporated into the said Order:-

<sup>2.</sup> Article 5.14 of the aforesaid Order is hereby rescinded and in its place these shall be incorporated –

<sup>&</sup>quot;(i) Where a Vehicle Waits in a Pay and Display Parking Place and there is displayed on the Vehicle in the Relevant Position a valid Parking Permit for that Parking Place or Reserved Parking Permit for that Parking Space in which the Vehicle is Waiting the Driver shall be exempt from the requirement to display a Parking Ticket."

- (ii)(a) Where a Vehicle Waits in a designated Disabled Person's Parking Space in a Pay and Display Parking Place and a valid Disabled Person's Badge is displayed on the Vehicle in the Relevant Position the Driver shall be exempt from the requirement to display a Parking Ticket for a period of up to three hours from the time at which the period of waiting shall have begun the commencement of such period to be marked by the insertion of the time in the clock on a parking disc which shall be displayed on the fascia or the front windscreen of the vehicle.
- (b) Where a Vehicle Waits in a Pay and Display Parking Place in the circumstances described in sub-article (ii)(a) of this Article it shall not return to the said Parking Place for a further period of such Waiting until a period of at least eight hours shall have elapsed since the conclusion of that first period of Waiting.

PROVIDED THAT nothing in this sub-article 2. (ii) shall be interpreted so as to refer to the Central Bus Station Multi-Storey Car Park

- (iii) Where a Vehicle Waits in the Central Bus Station Multi-Storey Car Park in a Pay and Display Parking Space or in a Disabled Person's Parking Space and a valid Disabled Person's Badge is displayed on the Vehicle in the Relevant Position the Driver shall be exempt from the requirement to display a Parking Ticket.
- 3. Article 6.1 (i) of the aforesaid Order is hereby rescinded and in its place there shall be incorporated —
- "(i) (a) a Vehicle Waiting within a designated Disabled Person's Parking Space in a Pay and Display Parking Place other than the Central Bus Station Multi-Storey Car Park for a period of up to three hours from the time at which the period of Waiting shall have begun which displays on the Vehicle in the Relevant Position a valid Disabled Person's Badge provided that the Vehicle shall not return to the said Parking Place for a further period of such Waiting until a period of at least eight hours shall have elapsed since the conclusion of that first period of Waiting."
- (b) a Vehicle Waiting within a Parking Space in the Central Bus Station Multi-Storey Car Park which displays on the Vehicle in the Relevant Position a valid Disabled Person's Badge provided that the Vehicle has been used or is about to be used by the person in respect of whom the Disabled Person's Badge is issued immediately before or immediately after the Vehicle was parked in the Parking Space;
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on the 2nd day of April 2016 and may be cited as the City Of Preston (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009 Amendment Order 2016
