READING BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Reading (Civil Enforcement Area) (Town Centre) (Red Route) (Experimental) Traffic Regulation Order 2020

The Reading Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "The Council"), pursuant to its powers under Sections 9 and 10 to The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (The Act of 1984) and Part IV of Schedule 9 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

This Order may be cited as "The Borough of Reading (Civil Enforcement Area) (Town Centre) (Red Route) (Experimental) Traffic Regulation Order 2020" and shall come into operation on 13 April 2020 for a period eighteen months from that date.

PART I GENERAL AND INTERPRETATION

- 1. Section 10(2) of the Act shall apply to this Order and the specified officer for the purposes of Section 10(2) of the Act shall be the Head of Transportation and Streetcare.
- 2. Definitions

In this Order:-

"Ambulance" has the same meaning as in the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994;

"Approved Payment Method" means park and phone, payment by debit or credit card facilitated by on site or remote verification by, for example, card reader or mobile phone text or phone call or decrementing card, payment by means of cash;

"Authorised Person" means an employee or agent of the Council authorised to exercise all or any of the functions of the Council under this Order;

"Authorised Agent" means the parking services contractor appointed by and acting on behalf of the Council for the purposes of the supervision and enforcement of this Order;

"Bus" has the same meaning as in Regulation 22 of the 2002 Regulations, and "Buses" shall be interpreted accordingly;

"Bus Stand" means any carriageway, intended for waiting Buses which is comprised of and indicated by a road-markings and incorporates the words "Bus Stand" and complies with Schedules 5 and 6 of the 2002 Regulations and diagrams 1025 of Schedule 5 and 975 of Schedule 6 thereof;

"Carriageway(s)" and "Footway(s)" have the same meaning as in Section 329 (1) of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended);

"Red Route" means the lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 701;

"Red Route Area" means the whole area of the Red Route being the Red Route length and width of the road including but not limited to the carriageway, footway and verges between the roads physical boundaries, boundary features or boundaries as depicted on the Highway Register as relevant,

"Relevant Position" in respect of: -

- (a) a Parking permit, means
 - (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, that the badge or permit is exhibited thereon with the front facing forward on the nearside of and immediately behind the windscreen; or
 - (ii) the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, that the badge or permit is exhibited on the front or nearside of the vehicle;
- (b) a Disabled Person's Badge, in accordance with Section 12 of The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

"Resident" means a person whose usual place of abode is at premises the postal address of which is in a road or part of a road specified in Schedule 499;

"Road(s)" has the same meaning as in Section 142 (1) of the Act;

"Specified Position" a vehicle left in a parking place during the permitted hours in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order shall cause it so to stand so that every part of a vehicle is within the limits of a parking place.

"Specified Hours" means the hours shown at the commencement of a Schedule containing parking or unloading places;

"Taxi Rank" means a rank for taxis available for immediate hire;

"2002 Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

- 3. (1) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order;
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment;
 - (3) The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment provided that where a prohibition or restriction which is imposed, varied or revoked by this Order is in conflict with a prohibition or restriction imposed by a previous Order, then the provision of this Order shall prevail;

- 11. The controls as specified in Article 4 and subject to the provisions of Article 21, shall not apply to any Motor Vehicle displaying a Disabled Persons Badge on the lengths of roads as detailed in Schedule 713 at any time Monday to Sunday inclusive for a period not longer than four (4) hours or, if a period of less than two (2 hours) has elapsed since the previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road.
- 12. The controls as specified in Article 4 and subject to the provisions of Article 21, shall not apply to any Motor Vehicle being actively loaded and/or unloaded on the lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 714 provided the Driver or owner of the vehicle remains for a maximum duration of 10 minutes only.
- 13. The controls as specified in Article 4, and subject to the provisions of Article 21, shall not apply to any person causing or permitting any licensed taxi and/or hackney carriage to wait in the signed licensed taxi and/or hackney carriage bays on the lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 716 to this Order.
- 14. The controls as specified in Article 4 and subject to the provisions of Article 21, shall not apply to:
 - a) any licensed taxi and/or hackney carriage waiting between the hours of 11.00a.m. to 5.00p.m.; or
 - b) any vehicle which has stopped for the purposes of actively loading and/or unloading between the hours of 5.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m.,

Monday to Sunday inclusive on the lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 717.

- 15. The controls as specified in Article 4 and subject to the provisions of Article 21, shall not apply to:
 - a) any licensed taxi and/or hackney carriage between the hours of 10.00p.m. to
 5.00 p.m.; or
 - b) any vehicle displaying a Disabled Persons Badge between the hours of 5.00 a.m. to 10.00p.m. only provided the Driver or owner of the vehicle remains for a maximum period of 4 hours only, no return within 2 hours Monday to Sunday on the lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 718.
- 16. The controls as specified in Article 4 and subject to the provisions of Article 21, shall not apply to:
 - a) any licensed taxi and/or hackney carriage between the hours of 8.00p.m. to 5.00 a.m.; or
 - b) any vehicle displaying a Disabled Persons Badge between the hours of 8.00 a.m. to 5.00p.m. only provided the Driver or owner of the vehicle remains for a maximum period of 4 hours only, no return within 2 hours Monday to Sunday on the lengths of roads as specified in Schedule 719.

- (f) using the vehicle for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (g) using the vehicle in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (h) using the vehicle in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any part of the red route or the red route area;
- (i) using the vehicle in connection with the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the red route of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984 (as amended);
- (j) using a vehicle in the service of a local authority, water authority or sewerage authority or their agents and in either case the vehicle is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- 2) The controls specified in Articles 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20 do not apply in respect of a person causing or permitting a Hackney Carriage or a Licensed Taxi to stop on a designated Taxi Rank during the hours of operation.
- The controls specified in Articles 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20 do not apply in respect of a person causing or permitting a Hackney Carriage or a Licensed Taxi to stop except for so long only as may be required to enable waiting passenger(s) to board or alight the vehicle.
- The controls specified in Articles 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20 do not apply in respect of a person causing or permitting a vehicle displaying a Disabled Persons Badge in the Relevant Position to stop for so long only as may be required to enable a disabled person to get in to or out of the vehicle.
- The controls specified in Articles 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20, do not apply in respect of a person causing or permitting a vehicle which bears the livery of Royal Mail to stop for as long as may be necessary to actively load and/or unload as necessary for the purposes of the provision of a universal postal service (as defined in the Postal Services Act 2011).
- The controls specified in Articles 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20 do not apply in respect of any persons causing or permitting a funeral Hearse to stop at or near any premises situated on or adjacent to the Red Route so long as it reasonably necessary to do so in connection with any funeral.

- (v) the service of a Local Authority or a Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; (c) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of providing a postal service as defined in section 27 Postal Services Act 2011;
- (d) the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of roads;
- the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of roads for so long as such waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral;
- (f) the vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.
- 24. (1) Nothing in Article 22 shall apply:-
 - (a) to any vehicle waiting for so long as may be necessary for the purpose of enabling goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (b) to a disabled person's vehicle, displaying a Disabled Persons Badge in accordance with Section 12 of The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;
 - (c) to a disabled person's vehicle, displaying a Disabled Persons Badge in the relevant position, waiting or stopping on the lengths of roads during specified limited waiting hours,

provided that such exemptions do not apply during the hours when loading restrictions are imposed by that Article.

- (2) Nothing in Article 22 shall apply to any vehicle:-
 - (a) waiting upon an authorised parking place; or
 - (b) being a Hackney Carriage or a Licensed Taxi waiting upon an authorised Taxi Rank; or
 - (c) waiting for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in the provision of a local service within the meaning of the Transport Act 1985.

PART IV AUTHORISATION AND USE OF PARKING PLACES

- 25. (1)
 - (a) The lengths of roads specified in Schedule 709, re authorised to be used;

33. Any person removing or causing to be removed a vehicle from a parking place in accordance with Article 33 shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle.

PART V ON STREET PARKING PLACES PAY AND DISPLAY

- 34. The Council may:-
 - (1) install, in such position or in the vicinity of a Pay and Display Parking Place as it may think fit, such ticket machines as are required by this Order for the purposes of that Pay and Display Parking Place; and
 - (2) carry out such other work as is authorised by this Order or is reasonably required for the purpose of that Pay and Display Parking Place.
- 35. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be left in an on-street parking place as authorised by this Order, unless it is one of the following specified class of vehicles:

disabled persons vehicle, dual purpose vehicle, goods vehicle being less than 3.5 tonnes, invalid carriage, Motor Cycles, motor tricycles, or a; passenger vehicle.

- 36. Any vehicle left in a Pay and Display Parking Place shall be positioned as specified in Schedules 720.
- 37. No vehicle shall display a parking ticket which has been previously displayed on another vehicle.
- 38. The minimum parking charge payable shall be in all cases for a vehicle left during the charging hours in a parking place specified in Schedule 720 for a minimum period of 20 minutes waiting, which, subject to the provisions of Article 40, shall not exceed a maximum period of waiting of no longer than two hours.
- 39. No vehicle which has been taken away from a parking place after the minimum charge had been incurred shall, until the expiration of two hours from the time it was taken away, again be left in that placing place during the charging hours.
- 40. The minimum parking charge payable shall be payable, on leaving of the vehicle in a parking place specified in Schedules 720 by the insertion in the ticket machine relating to the parking place in which the vehicle is left coins or other payment method as provided on site at the pay and display ticket machine. Where more than one coin is required, they shall be inserted in the ticket machine immediately one after the other.

- (3) The Council or authorised agent upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident who is the owner of a vehicle of the class specified in paragraph (1) of this Article, shall issue to the applicant a Residents parking Permit for the leaving during the permitted hours in a parking place of the vehicle to which such Permit relates, by the owner or by any person using such vehicle with the consent of the owner (other than a person to whom such vehicle has been let for hire and reward);
- (4) A resident shall not be entitled to be in possession of more than one Permit at any one occasion.
- (5) A Residents parking Permit shall only be a valid for use in a parking place specified in Schedules 709;
- 47. Notwithstanding the provisions contained in Article 46 the Council may also grant permits to such other persons as they may think fit.
- 48. (1) A permit holder, may surrender such permit to the Council or authorised agent at any time and shall surrender such permit to the Council or authorised agent on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article.
 - (2) The Council or authorised agent may, by notice in writing served on the permit holder at the address shown by that person on the application for the permit or at any other address believed to be that person's residence, withdraw a permit if it appears to the Council or authorised agent that any one of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article has occurred and the permit holder shall surrender the permit to the Council or authorised agent within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice.
 - (3) The events referred to in the foregoing provisions of this Article are:-
 - (a) the permit holder ceasing to be a resident;
 - (b) the permit holder ceasing to be the owner of the vehicle in respect of which the permit was issued;
 - (c) the vehicle in respect of which such permit was issued being adapted or used in such a manner that it is not a vehicle of the class specified in Article 46(1);
 - (d) the issue of a duplicate permit by the Council under the provisions of Article 51;
 - (e) the expiry of the period for which the Permit was issued;
 - (f) where a Permit is issued to any person upon receipt of a cheque and the cheque is subsequently dishonoured, the Permit shall cease to be of any effect;
