

REDCAR AND CLEVELAND BOROUGH COUNCIL
(RESIDENT PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (AMENDMENT) ORDER (NO. 2) 2005

Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (hereinafter called "the Council") under Sections 32(1) and 35(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the Act of 1984) and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the *27th* day of *October* 2005 and may be cited as the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Resident Parking) (Consolidation) (Amendment) Order (No. 2) 2005.
2. The Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Resident Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2003 ("the Order") is hereby amended as follows:-
 - (a) Article 3(1) of the Order is hereby amended to be read as follows:-

"3.(1) Each of the roads or parts of road specified in Part 2 of each sub-schedule of Schedule 6.00 to this Order is authorised as a parking place for use, subject to the following provisions of this Order, for the parking during such hours or such days and in such positions as are specified in this Order of such classes of vehicles, also so specified and which display in the relevant position a valid permit issued by the Council in respect of that vehicle".
 - (b) Articles 3(2), 3(3) and 3(4) of the Order are hereby revoked.
 - (c) Delete from sub-schedule 6.01 – Zone A (Part 1 – premises, premises entitled to parking permits) of the Order the following address:-

"1-89 and 2 – 78 Alfred Street"
 - (d) Insert to sub-schedule 6.01 – Zone A (Part 1 – premises, premises entitled to parking permits) of the Order the following address:-

1 – 89 and 2 – 78 Muriel Street
3. The provisions of existing Traffic Regulation Orders are revoked insofar as there are inconsistencies with this Order.
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

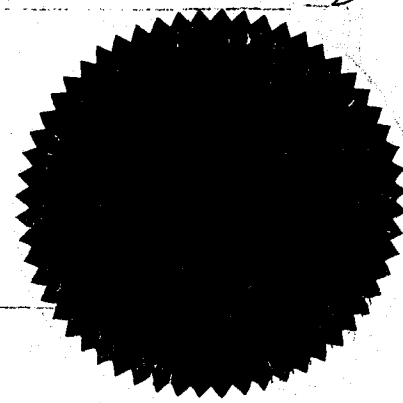
