

THE REDCAR AND CLEVELAND BOROUGH COUNCIL
(RESIDENT PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER (NO.1) 2004

Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (hereinafter called 'the Council') under Sections 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act of 1984') and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 14th day of December 2005 and may be cited as the Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Resident Parking) (Consolidation) (Amendment) Order (No.1) 2004.
2. The Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (Resident Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2003 ('the Order') is hereby amended as follows:-
 - (a) Insert to Sub Schedule 6.05 – Zone E, Part 2 (Parking Places) :-

Name of Parking Place

Position in which Vehicle May Wait

Arthur Street

West side. From a point 10 metres south of its junction with Newcomen Terrace for a distance of 5 metres in a southerly direction.

Henry Street

East side. From a point 10 metres south of its junction with Newcomen Terrace for a distance of 20 metres in a southerly direction.

East Side. From a point 10 metres south of its junction with Queen Street for a distance of 12 metres in a northerly direction.

Newcomen Terrace

West side. From a point 19 metres south of its junction with Majuba Road for a distance of 47 metres in a southerly direction.

- (b) Insert to Sub Schedule 6.19 – Zone W, Part 2 (Parking Places) :-

Name of Parking Place

Position in which Vehicle May Wait

High Street West

North side. From a point 10 metres east of its junction with Hill Street for a distance of 37 metres in an easterly direction.

North side. From a point 10 metres west of Lobster Roadt for a distance of 12 metres in a westerly direction.
