(AMENDMENT) (NO. 20) ORDER 2011**

CALDERBROOK ROAD, LITTLEBOROUGH

The Rochdale Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 124(1) and paragraph 20(1) of Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Rochdale ((Civil Enforcement of Traffic Contraventions) (Various Streets) (Pennines Township) Order 2008) (Amendment) (No. 20) Order 2011 and shall come into operation on 1st June 2011.
2. The Borough of Rochdale (Civil Enforcement of Traffic Contraventions) (Various Streets) (Pennines Township) Order 2008 is hereby amended by inserting the wording shown in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

**Schedule No. 1.1
No Waiting at Any Time**

Ashworth Close, Littleborough - Lakeside Ward

both sides from its junction with Calderbrook Road for a distance of 15 metres in a westerly direction

Calder Avenue, Littleborough - Lakeside Ward

both sides from its junction with Calderbrook Road for a distance of 15 metres in a westerly direction

Calderbrook Road, Littleborough - Lakeside Ward

- n (vii) the westerly side from a point 15 metres north of its junction with Ashworth Close for a distance of 34 metres in a southerly direction
- n (viii) the westerly side from a point 10 metres north of its junction with Calder Avenue for a distance of 25 metres in a south west direction
- n (vix) the westerly side from a point 26 metres north east of its junction with Whalley Avenue for a distance of 48 metres in a south west direction
- n (x) the easterly side from a point 15 metres south of its junction with Denhurst Road for a distance of 105 metres in a north east direction

Denhurst Road, Littleborough - Lakeside Ward

- n (i) the northerly side from its junction with Calderbrook Road for a distance of 137 metres in a south east direction
- n (ii) the southerly side from its junction with Calderbrook Road for a distance of 23 metres in a south east direction

Whalley Avenue, Littleborough - Lakeside Ward

both sides from its junction with Calderbrook Road for a distance of 15 metres in a north west direction
