

## THE ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (ROCHFORD DISTRICT) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND (ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. 11) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Chelmsford City Council acting on behalf of the South Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 30 June 2022 has made the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers.

**Effect of the Order:** To introduce or amend parking restrictions on the following lengths of road in the District of Rochford as specified below. All measurements are approximate and are taken from the extended kerb line unless stated otherwise.

1. To revoke 'No Waiting Monday to Friday 11am-3pm' and replace with 'Limited Waiting Monday to Saturday 8am-6pm, 2 hours, no return within 2 hours':

Castle Drive,	Northeast Side: From a point 18 metres southeast of its junction with

**Application to the High Court:** Anyone who wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
