

**THE ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (ROCHFORD DISTRICT)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND
(ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA)
(AMENDMENT NO. 13) ORDER 2024**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Chelmsford City Council acting on behalf of the South Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 30 June 2022 has made the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers.

Effect of the Order: To introduce parking restrictions on the following lengths of road in the District of Rochford as specified below. All measurements are approximate and are taken from the extended kerb line unless stated otherwise.

1. To introduce ‘No Waiting at Any Time’:

Road	Description
Daws Heath Road, Rayleigh	Southwest Side: From a point 10 metres southeast of its junction with Woodlands Avenue, north-westwards to a point 10 metres northwest of the junction. TILE: TQ810 900 Rev. 0 to Rev. 1
Woodlands Avenue, Rayleigh	Both Sides: From its junction with Daws Heath Road, south-westwards for 10 metres. Both Sides: From a point 10 metres northeast of its junction with Woodlands Close, south-westwards to a point 10 metres southwest of the junction. Both Sides: From a point 4 metres southeast of the shared boundary of Nos. 28 & 30 Woodlands Avenue, south-eastwards for its remaining length (including the turning circle). TILES: TQ805 897 Rev. 0 to Rev. 1, TQ810 897 Rev. 0 to Rev. 1 & TQ810 900 Rev. 0 to Rev. 1
Woodlands Close, Rayleigh	Both Sides: From its junction with Woodlands Avenue, north-westwards for 10 metres. Both Sides: From a point 5 metres southeast of the shared boundary of Nos. 11 & 12 Woodlands Close, north-westwards for its remaining length (including the turning head). TILE: TQ805 897 Rev. 0 to Rev. 1

2. To introduce ‘Permit Parking Area Zone L Monday to Friday 10-11am and 2-3pm’:

Road	Description
Woodlands Avenue, Rayleigh	Both Sides: From a point 10 metres southwest of its junction with Daws Heath Road to a point 10 metres northeast of its junction with Woodlands Close. Both Sides: From a point 10 metres southwest of its junction with Woodlands Close, south-westwards and south-eastwards to a point 4 metres southeast of the shared boundary of Nos. 28 & 30 Woodlands Avenue. TILES: TQ805 897 Rev. 0 to Rev. 1 & TQ810 897 Rev. 0 to Rev. 1
Woodlands Close, Rayleigh	Both Sides: From a point 10 metres northwest of its junction with Woodlands Avenue, north-westwards to a point 5 metres southeast of the shared boundary of Nos. 11 & 12 Woodlands Close. TILE: TQ805 897 Rev. 0 to Rev. 1

The Essex County Council (Rochford District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 Schedule 5 will be amended to include the following properties the residents of which are eligible to apply for a permit:

Road	Zone	Properties
Woodlands Avenue, Rayleigh	L	All residential properties
Woodlands Close, Rayleigh	L	All residential properties

Date of operation: This Order will come into operation on **Monday 21st October 2024.**

Application to the High Court: Anyone who wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
