No waiting at any time

Piccadilly Road and Fitzwilliam Street Swinton Rotherham

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the RTRA 1984"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the TMA 2004"), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 ("CEoPC General Regulations 2007") and all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984 and in pursuance of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Rotherham) Order 2005 made by the Secretary of State for Transport hereby makes the following Order:-

The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 ("the 2011 Order") shall have effect as though the words specified in the Schedule hereto were included in Schedule 1 of the 2011 Order "No Waiting At Any Time"

Piccadilly Road, Swinton

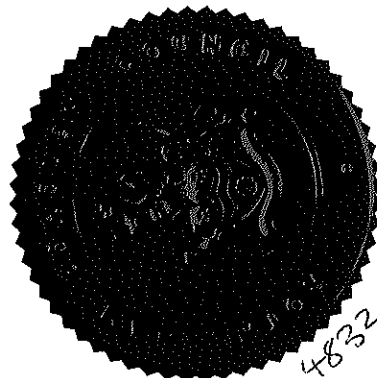
Both sides – from its junction with Fitzwilliam Street for a distance of 15m in a southerly direction.

Fitzwilliam Street, Swinton

West side – from a point 33m northwest of the point where the extended northern kerbline of Piccadilly Road meets the extended western kerbline of Fitzwilliam Street for a distance of 74m in a generally south easterly direction.

This Order is made on the 8th. April 2021 and shall come into force on the 12th. April 2021 and may be cited as "The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 (Amendment No.196) Order 2021.
