(BROOM ROAD, ROTHERHAM)
(BUS AND HGV LANE) ORDER 2023

Broom Road Broom Rotherham

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Section 19 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

This Order shall have the effect as though:

- (i) The Rotherham Borough Council (The South Yorkshire County Council (Various roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Measures Consolidation) Order 1985) (Amendment No. 4) Order 1989) (Amendment No.39) 1998 is revoked;
- (ii) Introduce the prohibition of all motor vehicles other than a bus and a heavy goods vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in the bus lanes specified in the Schedule to this Order;

1. In this Order:-

"bus lane" means the marked area of carriageway of an approximate width of 3.0m described in the Schedule to this Order

"bus" has the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981

"Heavy Goods Vehicle" means a motor vehicle or trailer constructed or adapted for use for the carriage or haul burden of any description (and a reference in a diagram to "t" is to the maximum tonnes)

- 2. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no Vehicle other than a bus or Heavy Goods Vehicle (HGV) shall enter, proceed or wait in the bus and cycle lane except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform.
- 3. (1) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful for any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in the bus lane if and so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) the vehicle to be used in an emergency for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water company or of a statutory undertaker in pursuance of statutory powers or duties

(c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other part of road, to be used in connection with any building, industrial or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the part of road referred to, or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or near the said part of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (2) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful for public service vehicles as defined in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 to enter, proceed or wait in the bus lane.

Introduce

With flow Bus and HGV lane

Broom Road, Broom, Rotherham

South side from its junction with the western kerb line of Fraser Road to its junction with the southern kerb line of Broom Terrace

4. This Order is made on the 20th. day of September 2023 and shall come into force on the 25th. day of September 2023 and may be cited as The Rotherham Borough Council (Broom Road, Broom, Rotherham) (Bus and HGV Lane) Order 2023.
