

EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER TO AMEND  
THE ROTHERHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL  
(VARIOUS ROADS, ROTHERHAM)  
(TRAFFIC REGULATION CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2011  
ORDER 2020

Disabled Residents Designated Parking Place – Beech Road  
Wath Upon Dearne Rotherham

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of the powers under Sections 9 and 10 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984), as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on the 19<sup>th</sup>. October 2020 to remain in force for 18 months and may be cited as the Experimental Traffic Regulation Order to Amend The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation Order) 2011 Order 2019.
2. The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 shall have effect as though there were inserted in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Schedule 41 thereto the following words:

3. Under Section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Director of Streetpride or any other person authorised by him may modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it if it appears to him essential:-
  - (a) in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic
  - (b) in the interest of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities or

- (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road affected by the Order runs

This power shall be exercised only after consulting of the appropriate Chief Officer of Police and giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct.
