Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the RTRA 1984"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the TMA 2004"), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 ("CEoPC General Regulations 2007") and all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984 and in pursuance of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Rotherham) Order 2005 made by the Secretary of State for Transport hereby makes the following Order:-

2. The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 ('the 2011 Order') shall have effect as though the words specified in the Schedule hereto were included in Schedule 1 of the 2011 Order "No Waiting At Any Time"

Schedule 1 No Waiting at Any Time

Kea Park Close, Hellaby

- i Northern kerbline from the extended Eastern kerbline of Denby Way for a distance of 46.00m in an Easterly direction.
- ii Northern kerbline from the extended Wetsern kerbline of Kea Park Close for a distance of 22.00m in a Westerly direction.
- iii Western kerbline from the extended Northern kerbline of Kea Park Close for a distance of 37.00m in a Northerly direction.

- iv Western kerbline from a point 44.00m from the extended Northern kerbline of Kea Park Close for a distance of 14.00m in a Northerly direction.

This Order is made on the 21<sup>st</sup>. January 2016 and shall come into force on the 25<sup>th</sup>. January 2016 and may be cited as "The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 (Amendment No.103) Order 2016.
