No waiting at any time

Netherfield Lane and Morley Street Rawmarsh Rotherham

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the RTRA 1984"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the TMA 2004"), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 ("CEoPC General Regulations 2007") and all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984 and in pursuance of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Rotherham) Order 2005 made by the Secretary of State for Transport hereby makes the following Order:-

- 2. The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 ('the 2011Order") shall have effect as though:-
 - (i) the words specified in Schedule 1 hereto were included in Schedule 1 of the 2011 Order "No Waiting At Any Time"
 - (ii) the words specified in Schedule 2 hereto were included in Schedule 10 of the 2011 Order "No Waiting At Any Time Mon-Sat 8am-4pm"

Schedule 1 No Waiting at Any Time

Netherfield Lane, Rawmarsh

- (i) The north side from a point 63 metres from its junction with the eastern kerb line of Rawmarsh Hill for a distance of 14 metres in an easterly direction.
- (ii) The south side from its junction with the western kerb line of Morley Street for a distance of 2 metres in a westerly direction.
- (iii) The south side from the projected eastern kerb line of Morley Street for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.
- (iv) The south side from a point 21 metres east of the projected eastern kerbline of Morley Street for a distance of 24 metres.

Morley Street, Rawmarsh

 Both sides from its junction with the southern kerb line of Netherfield Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

Netherfield Lane, Rawmarsh

- (i) The north side from a point 26 metres from its junction with the eastern kerb line of Rawmarsh Hill for a distance of 37 metres in an easterly direction.
- (ii) The south side from a point 10 metres east of the projected eastern kerb line of Morley Street for a distance of 11 metres in an easterly direction.

This Order is made on the 24th. March 2016 and shall come into force on the 28th March 2016 and may be cited as "The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 (Amendment No.62) Order 2016
