## ROTHERHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL THE ROTHERHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, ROTHERHAM) (TRAFFIC REGULATIONS CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2005 (AMENDMENT NO.56) ORDER 2008

- 1. Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1, 2, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter called "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:
- 2. The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulations Consolidation) Order 2005 shall have effect as though:

Schedule No. 1 No Waiting At Any Time the following words were deleted under the heading Aldwarke Road, Parkgate at items (ii) & (iii)

- (ii) the south side from a point opposite the western kerb line of Parkfield Court for a distance of 33 metres in a westerly direction and then 13 metres in a northerly direction across its termination and finally for a distance of 13 metres in a south easterly direction
- the south west side from a point 13 metres north west of the junction with the western kerb line of Cross Street to its junction with Great Eastern Way in a south easterly direction

and replaced with the following words under the heading Aldwarke Road, Parkgate at items (ii) & (iii)

- (ii) from a point 78 metres north west of the western kerb line of Cross Street for a distance of 70 metres in a north westerly direction and then 13 metres in a northerly direction across its termination and finally for a distance of 11 metres in a south easterly direction
- (iii) from a point 30 metres north west of the junction with western kerb line of Cross Street to its junction with Great Eastern Way in a south easterly direction
- 3. The Order shall come into force of the 21 day of April 2008 and may be cited as "The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulations Consolidation) Order 2005 (Amendment No.56) Order 2008
