Drummond Street service road and Eastwood Lane Rotherham Town Centre

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the RTRA 1984"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the TMA 2004"), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 ("CEoPC General Regulations 2007") and all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984 and in pursuance of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Rotherham) Order 2005 made by the Secretary of State for Transport hereby makes the following Order:-

2. The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 ("the 2011 Order") shall have effect as though the words specified in the Schedule hereto were included in Schedule 1 of the 2011 Order "No Waiting At Any Time"

Schedule 1 No Waiting at Any Time

**Drummond Street service Road, Rotherham Town centre**

The South West side from its junction with the North Western kerb line of Eastwood Lane for a distance of 8 metres in a North Westerly direction.

**Eastwood Lane, Rotherham Town centre**

The North West side from the junction with the South Western kerblines of Drummond Street service Road for a distance of 9 metres in a South Westerly direction.

This Order is made on the 8<sup>th</sup>. October 2015 and shall come into force on the 12<sup>th</sup>. October 2015 and may be cited as "The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 (Amendment No.99) Order 2015.
