Prohibition of Verge Parking

Corporation Street Main Street and Mansfield Road Rotherham Town Centre

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the RTRA 1984"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the TMA 2004"), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 ("CEoPC General Regulations 2007") and all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984 and in pursuance of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Rotherham) Order 2005 made by the Secretary of State for Transport hereby makes the following Order:-

- 2. The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 ('the 2011 Order) shall have effect as though:
 - (i) the words specified in Schedule 1 hereto were included in Part 1 of the 2011 Order "2.1 Definitions" under the headings and numbered items specified therein
 - (ii) the words specified in Schedule 2 hereto were deleted from Part 2 of the 2011 Order "11 Prohibition of Verge Parking" under the headings and numbered items specified therein
 - (iii) the words specified in Schedule 3 hereto were included in Part 2 of the 2011 Order "11 Prohibition of Verge or Footway Parking" under the headings and numbered items specified therein
 - (iv) the words specified in Schedule 4 hereto were included in Schedule 19 of the 2011 Order "Prohibition of Verge or Footway Parking" under the headings and numbered items specified therein

Part 1 General 2.1 Definitions

The area of land which is designated for pedestrian use only between the edge of the carriageway and the highway boundary

Prohibition of Verge of Footway Parking

Corporation Street, Rotherham

West side from its junction with the northern kerb line of the entrance to the Riverside car park for a distance of 33 metres in a northerly direction.

West side from its junction with the northern kerb line of the entrance to the Riverside car park for a distance of 9 metres in a southerly direction.

East side from a point opposite its junction with the northern kerb line of the entrance to the Riverside car park for a distance of 14 metres in a northerly direction.

East side from a point opposite its junction with the northern kerb line of the entrance to the Riverside car park for a distance of 9 metres in a southerly direction.

Main Street, Rotherham

Both sides from its junction with the western kerb line of Don Street for a distance of 31 metres in a westerly direction.

South side from a point opposite the eastern kerb line of Market Street for a distance of 9 metres in an easterly direction.

South side from a point opposite the eastern kerb line of Market Street for a distance of 34 metres in a westerly direction.

Mansfield Road, Rotherham

Both sides from its junction with Wellgate for a distance of 25 metres in a south westerly direction.

This Order is made on the 7th. January 2016 and shall come into force on the 11th. January 2016 and may be cited as "The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 (Amendment No.93) Order 2016.
