Prohibition of Waiting – Ryton Road and Bennett Croft North Anston Sheffield

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, and 4, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the RTRA 1984"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the TMA 2004"), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 ("CEoPC General Regulations 2007") and all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984 and in pursuance of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Rotherham) Order 2005 made by the Secretary of State for Transport hereby makes the following Order:-

2. The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 ('the 2011 Order) shall have effect as though the following words were included in "Schedule 1 No Waiting At Any Time" of the 2011 Order under the headings specified in the Schedule below:-

Schedule

**Ryton Road, North Anston**

- i 

North-western kerbline from the extended North-eastern kerbline of Bennett Croft for a distance of 5.00m in a North-easterly direction.
  
- ii 

North-western kerbline from the extended South-western kerbline of Bennett Croft for a distance of 5.00m in a South-westerly direction.

**Bennett Croft, North Anston**

- i 

Both sides in a North-westerly direction for a distance of 10.00m from the extended North-western kerbline of Ryton Road.

This Order is made on the 24<sup>th</sup>. day of March 2016 and shall come into force on the 28<sup>th</sup>. day of March 2016 and may be cited as "The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 (Amendment No.97) Order 2016".
