

THE ROTHERHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL  
(OFF STREET) (PARKING PLACES)  
CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2011  
(AMENDMENT NO.4) ORDER 2013

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the RTRA 1984") (as amended), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the TMA 2004"), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 ("CEoPC General Regulations 2007") and all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984 and in pursuance of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area)(Metropolitan Borough of Rotherham) Order 2005 made by the Secretary of State for Transport hereby makes the following Order:-

**1. COMMENCEMENT AND CITATION**

This Order is made on the 20<sup>th</sup>. June 2013 and shall come into force on the 24<sup>th</sup>. June 2013 and may be cited as "The Rotherham Borough Council (Off-Street) (Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2011 (Amendment No.4) Order 2012.

2. The Rotherham Borough Council (Off Street) (Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2011 (the 2011 Consolidation Order) shall have effect as though the Words specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order were deleted from the Schedule to the 2011 Consolidation Order under the heading 'Position in which a vehicle may wait' and the words specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order were included in the Schedule to the 2011 Consolidation Order under the heading 'Position in which a vehicle may wait'

**SCHEDULE**

**Part 1**

To be revoked:

Wholly within a Parking Bay or as indicated by a notice or notices

**Part 2**

To be introduced:

- (a) Wholly within a Parking Bay or as indicated by a notice or notices
- (b) Vehicles driven by external visitors (i.e. not Council employees) for which a prior booking has been made in parking bay numbers 137 to 148 and a valid pay and display ticket must be displayed
