No waiting at any time

Sheffield Road and Phoenix Riverside Templeborough Rotherham

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the RTRA 1984"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the TMA 2004"), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 ("CEoPC General Regulations 2007") and all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984 and in pursuance of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Rotherham) Order 2005 made by the Secretary of State for Transport hereby makes the following Order:-

The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 ("the 2011 Order") shall have effect as though the words specified in the Schedule hereto were included in Schedule 1 of the 2011 Order "No Waiting At Any Time"

Schedule 1 No Waiting at Any Time

Sheffield Road, Rotherham

North sides from its junction with Bessemer Way to its junction with Centenary Way in a north easterly direction.

South sides from its junction with Bessemer Way, for a distance of 375m in a north easterly direction.

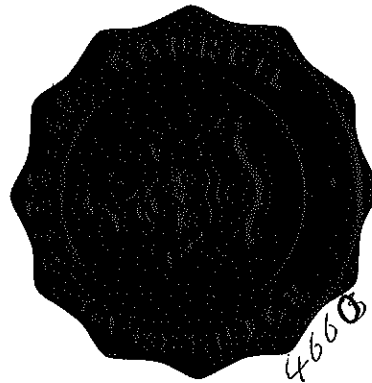
South sides from a point 423m north east of the junction with Bessemer Way for a distance of 448m in a north easterly direction.

Phoenix Riverside, Rotherham

Both sides from its junction with Sheffield Road, for a distance of 10m in a north westerly direction.

This Order is made on the 24th. January 2019 and shall come into force on the 28th. January 2019 and may be cited as "The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 (Amendment No.174) Order 2019.
