Stokewell Road West Melton and Chestnut Avenue Wath Upon Dearne Rotherham

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the RTRA 1984"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the TMA 2004"), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 ("CEoPC General Regulations 2007") and all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984 and in pursuance of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Rotherham) Order 2005 made by the Secretary of State for Transport hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Rotherham Borough Council Various Roads Brampton Swinton Wath and West Melton (No Stopping on School Entrance Markings) Order 2010 ('the 2010 Order) shall have effect as though the words specified in the Schedule hereto were included in the Schedule of the 2010 Order 'No Stopping 07.30 am to 5.00 pm Monday to Friday (Inclusive) on School Entrance Markings'

Schedule

West Melton Primary School Stokewell Road, West Melton

North side – commencing 95m west of the point where the extended northern kerbline of Stokewell Road meets the extended western kerbline of Oak Lea Avenue for a distance of 25.56m in a westerly direction.

Saint Pius X Catholic High School Chestnut Avenue, Wath

South side – commencing 32m east of the point where the extended eastern kerbline of Sandygate meet the extended southern kerbline of Chestnut Avenue for a distance of 25.56m in an easterly direction.

2. This Order is made on the 26th. April 2018 and shall come into force on the 30th. April 2018 and may be cited as "The Rotherham Borough Council Various Roads Brampton Swinton Wath and West Melton (No Stopping on School Entrance Markings) Order 2010 (Amendment No.7) Order 2018.
