(ORDER 1999) (AMENDMENT) (ORDER 2005) ORDER 2024

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the RTRA 1984"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the TMA 2004"), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 ("CEoPC General Regulations 2007") and all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984 and in pursuance of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Rotherham) Order 2005 made by the Secretary of State for Transport hereby makes the following Order:-

2. The Rotherham Borough Council (A631 Bawtry Road – Westbound) (Bus Lane and Prohibition of Stopping, Loading and Unloading) (order 1999) (Amendment) (Order 2005) ("the 2005 Order") shall have effect as though:

- (i) the words specified in Schedule 1 hereto were deleted from the 2005 Order
- (ii) the words specified in Schedule 2 hereto were included in the 2005 Order

Schedule 1

To be revoked

Bus Lane and Prohibition of Stopping, Loading and Unloading
A631 Bawtry Road - Westbound

South side – from its junction with the eastern kerb line of Morthen Road for a distance of 570 metres in an easterly direction.

Schedule 2

To be introduced

Bus Lane and Prohibition of Stopping, Loading and Unloading
A631 Bawtry Road – Westbound


South side – from its junction with the eastern kerb line of Morthen Road for a distance of 623 metres in an easterly direction.
