(AMENDMENT NO. 93) ORDER 2024
Forge Island Development Car Park Rotherham**

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the RTRA 1984”) (as amended), the Traffic Management Act 2004 (“the TMA 2004”), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 (“CEoPC General Regulations 2007”) and all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984 and in pursuance of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area)(Metropolitan Borough of Rotherham) Order 2005 made by the Secretary of State for Transport hereby makes the following Order:-

1. COMMENCEMENT AND CITATION

This Order is made on the 15th. April 2024 and shall come into force on the 29th. April 2024 and may be cited as “The Rotherham Borough Council (Off-Street) (Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2011 (Amendment No. 93) Order 2024
