No waiting at any time
Mortain Road Lymister Avenue and Stafford Drive Moorgate Rotherham

Rotherham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the RTRA 1984"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the TMA 2004"), the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 ("CEoPC General Regulations 2007") and all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the RTRA 1984 and in pursuance of the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Rotherham) Order 2005 made by the Secretary of State for Transport hereby makes the following Order:-

2. The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 ("the 2011 Order") shall have effect as though the words specified in the Schedule hereto were included in the Schedule of the 2011 Order "No Waiting at any time" of the 2011 Order

Schedule No 1
No waiting at any time

Mortain Road

- i North side from a point 10 metres south east of its junction with Hallam Road for a distance of 92m in a south westerly direction.
- ii South side from a point 10 south east of its junction with Hallam Road for a distance of 61 metres in a south westerly direction

Lymister Avenue

- i both sides from a point 10 metres south east of its junction with Mortain road to a point 10 metres south east of the southern kerb line of Stafford Drive.

Stafford Drive

- i both sides from its junction with Hallam Road for a distance of 10 metres in a south westerly direction

This Order is made on the 30th. June 2022 and shall come into force on the 4th. July 2022 and may be cited as "The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 (Amendment No.199) Order 2022.
