2. The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 ('the 2011 Order) shall have effect as though the words specified in the Schedule hereto were included in the Schedule of the 2011 Order "No Waiting at any time" of the 2011 Order

Spinnyfield

- i Both sides from its junction with A618 Moorgate for a distance of 60 metres in a north easterly direction.
- ii Both sides from its junction with Broom Lane for a distance of 53 metres in a south westerly direction.

Grange Road

i Both sides from its junction with Broom Lane for a distance of 17 metres in a south westerly direction.

Broom Lane

i South west side from a point 15 metres south east of its junction with Grange Road, to a point 35 metres north west of its junction with Spinnyfield. ii North east side from a point 5 metres south east of its junction with the south eastern kerb line of Broom Avenue to a projection of the boundary of 103/105 Broom Lane

This Order is made on the 4th. August 2022 and shall come into force on the 8th. August 2022 and may be cited as "The Rotherham Borough Council (Various Roads, Rotherham) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2011 (Amendment No.199) Order 2022.
