The Council of the Borough of Runnymede ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32 and 35 (1) and (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers with the consent of the County Council of Surrey given under Section 39(3) of the Act and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

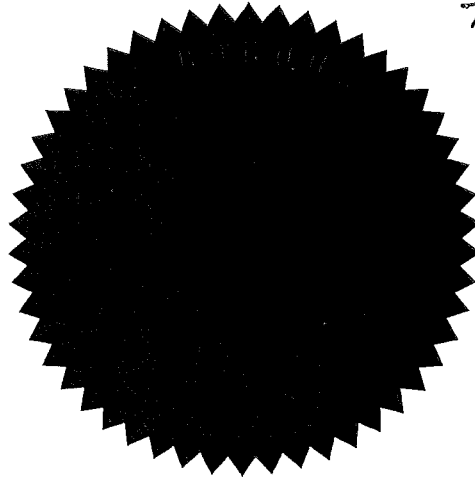
The Borough of Runnymede (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2008 (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order ") shall have effect as if :-

1. Schedule 21 in Schedule 1 to this Order was inserted after Schedule 20 of the Principal Order.
2. A reference to Schedule 21 was inserted within Articles 4(4), 5, 9, 25(1), 25(2), 25(9) and 25(10) of the Principal Order.
3. The Order may be cited as the "Borough of Runnymede (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment) (No. 1) Order 2015" and shall come into operation on 2 March 2015.

For up to 3 hours, with a return being made within 3 hours - a "Penalty Charge" of £50 shall be payable except that if payment is made within fourteen days of the date of the issue of a notice under Article 27(1) of the Order the Council will
