THE RUSHMOOR BOROUGH COUNCIL (ONE-WAY STREETS AND OTHER PRESCRIBED DIRECTIONS, FARNBOROUGH) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER, 2013

Rushmoor Borough Council ("the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 with the Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), Part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (County of Hampshire) (Borough of Rushmoor) Order, 2002 the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby make the following Order, the effect of which is:-

- 1.This Order may be cited, as the Rushmoor Borough Council (One-Way Streets and Other Prescribed Directions, Farnborough) (Consolidation) Order, 2013 and shall come into operation on the 2nd December, 2013.
- 2.No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order other than in the direction specified in that Schedule.
- 3.No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle or pedal cycle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 4.No person shall cause any motor vehicle proceeding along the roads specified in Column (1) of Schedule 3 of this Order to make a right-hand turn into the roads specified in Column (2) of the said Schedule.
- 5.All vehicles proceeding in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 of this Order shall be required to turn left only as specified in the said Schedule.
- 6.No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to perform a 'U' Turn at the points in the roads specified in Schedule 5 of this order.
- 7.No person shall cause or permit any vehicle approaching the signalised road junction referred to in Column (1) of Schedule 6, positioned in the lane referred to in Column (2) to turn in any direction other than the direction referred to in Column (3) in the said Schedule.
- 8.No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle except Hackney Carriages, Goods Vehicles performing loading/unloading, and those vehicles requiring access to off-street premises to proceed in that section of Eastmead referred to in Schedule 7 of this Order.
- 9. The Orders specified in Schedule 8 to this Order are hereby revoked in part (as they relate to this Order) or in full and consolidated into this single Order.

- 10. Emergency services vehicles engaged on operational work are exempt from the restrictions in this Order.
- 11. The Council in exercise of its powers under the Local Authorities (Transport Charges) Regulations 1998 (SI 1998 No. 948) and the Order may make a reasonable charge for any dispensation issued in contravention of any traffic regulation order contained in this Consolidation Order to cover the cost of administration.

SCHEDULE 1 One-Way Streets

Alison Close

From its junction with St. Christopher's Road in a westerly direction to its junction with Wilson Road.

Bridge Road

From its northern junction with Cove Road in a south easterly direction to its southern junction with Cove Road.

Church Path

From a point 13 metres south of its junction with Rectory Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Church Avenue.

Clockhouse Road

From its junction with Farnborough Road for a distance of 15 metres in a north westerly direction.

Cove Road

From its eastern junction with Bridge Road in a north westerly direction to its northern junction with Bridge Road.

Elmsleigh Road

From its junction with Cove Road for a distance of 20 metres in a northerly direction.

Gordon Road

From its junction with Morris Road in a westerly direction to its junction with Peabody Road.

Guildford Road West

From its junction with Alexandra Road for a distance of 30 metres in a westerly direction.

Morris Road

From its junction with the A3011 Lynchford Road in a northerly direction to its junction with High Street.

Murray Road

From its junction with Wilson Road in an easterly direction to its junction with St. Christopher's Road.

Northmead

From its junction with Westmead in a westerly and northerly direction to its junction with Victoria Road.

Park Road

From its junction with Old Lynchford Road in a northerly direction to its junction with Queens Road.

Westmead

From its junction with Victoria Road in a southerly direction to its junction with Northmead.

Wilson Road

From its junction with Alison Close in a northerly direction to its junction with Hunter Road.

Wood Lane

From its southern junction with St. Christopher's Road in an easterly and then a northerly direction to its northern junction with St. Christopher's Road.

SCHEDULE 2 Prohibition of Driving

Alison Close

From its junction with Wilson Road for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.

Bridge Road

From its southern junction with Cove Road for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

Church Path

From its junction with Church Avenue for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

Clockhouse Road

From a point 15 metres north west of its junction with Farnborough Road for a distance of 15 metres in a south easterly direction.

Cove Road

From a point on its northern junction with Bridge Road for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

Elmsleigh Road

From a point 20 metres north of its junction with Cove Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 20 metres.

Gordon Road

From its junction with Peabody Road for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.

Guildford Road West

From a point 30 metres west of its junction with Alexandra Road for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.

Hazel Avenue

From a point 280 metres north of its junction with Cody Road, Arrow Road and Marrowbrook Lane in a northerly direction to a point 110 metres south of its junction with Dene Road.

Morris Road

From its junction with High Street for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

Murray Road

From its junction with St. Christopher's Road for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction.

Northmead

From its junction with Victoria Road for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

Park Road

From its junction with Queens Road for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

Wilson Road

From its junction with Hunter Road for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.

Wood Lane

From its northern junction with St. Christopher's Road for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction.
