# THE RUSHMOOR BOROUGH COUNCIL (SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS IN ALDERSHOT AND FARNBOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND WAITING) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER, 2009

The Rushmoor Borough Council, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Council of the County of Hampshire in exercise of the powers conferred on that County Council under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Rushmoor Borough Council (School Entrance Marking in Aldershot and Farnborough) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting) (Consolidation) Order, 2009 and shall come into operation on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2009.
- 2 Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop or remain at rest in the sides or lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order between the hours of 8.00 am and 5.00 pm, Mondays to Fridays inclusive.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply:-
  - (a) To any person causing or permitting any vehicle to stop or remain at rest:-
    - (i) If the person is obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident;
    - (ii) If that person is required to do so by law
  - (b) In relation to any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency; or
  - (c) To anything done with the permission or at the direction of the police or a civil enforcement officer.
  - (d) To a vehicle being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration or repair in the lengths of road concerned of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication system as defined in the Telecommunications Act, 1984.
  - (e) To any vehicles being used in the service of a local authority in exercise of statutory powers or duties and whilst being so used service it is necessary for the vehicle to wait in the lengths of road.
- 4. For the purposes of this Order, the following Orders are hereby revoked:-
  - The Rushmoor Borough Council (School Entrance Markings in Aldershot and Farnborough) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting) Order, 2006
  - The Rushmoor Borough Council (School Entrance Markings in Aldershot and Farnborough) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting) (Experimental) Order, 2008
- 5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the 1984 Act, or by or under any other enactment.

From the boundary of Nos. 64/66 Belle Vue Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 43 metres.

From a point 1.5 metres east of the boundary of Nos. 89/91 Haig Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 37 metres.

From a point 8 metres east of the eastern wall of No.109 Haig Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 27 metres.

From a point 1 metre east of the boundary of Nos. 117/119 Newport Road to a point 14 metres west of the western boundary wall of No. 115 Newport Road.

From a point 4.5 metres east of the eastern boundary of No. 42 Newport Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 51.5 metres.

### **George Gardens**

From its junction with the north-east/south-west section of George Gardens in a North-

Westerly direction to the end of the cul-de-sac.

From a point 4 metres north-west of the boundary of Nos. 5/6 in a North-Westerly direction to and including the end of the cul-de-sac.

From the north-eastern boundary of No. 14 George Gardens in a north easterly direction to its junction with the south-east/north-west section of George Gardens.

### Gloucester Road - North East Side

From a point 4 metres north west of the boundary of Nos. 3/5 Gloucester Road in a North – Westerly direction for a distance of 25 metres.

From a point 5 metres east of the boundary of No. 93 Coronation Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 26 metres.

#### Park Road - North Side

From a point 4 metres west of the boundary of Nos. 86/88 Park Road in a Westerly direction for a distance of 28 metres.

From a point 2 metres north – west of the south eastern boundary of No 128 Church Lane east in a South-Easterly direction for a distance of 39 metres.

From a point 30.5 metres east of the mid point of the access to Grange Junior School in a Westerly direction for a distance of 49 metres.

From the centre of the footpath leading to Northcote Road in a northerly distance for a distance of 13 metres and from the same point in a southerly direction for a distance of 13 metres.

From a point 1 metres north of the northern boundary of the entrance to St Patrick's School in a southerly direction for a distance of 26 metres.

#### Avenue Road – East Side

From the boundary of Nos. 18/20 Avenue Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 24 metres.

#### **St Peters Junior School**

#### Church Avenue – East Side

from a point 15 metres north of the boundary of Nos. 43/45 Church Avenue in a Northerly direction to a point 6 metres north of the boundary of Nos. 47/49 Avenue Road.

From opposite the eastern boundary of No. 108 Reading Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 49 metres.

From a point 1 metre west of its junction with Windsor Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 43 metres.

From a point 9 metres north of the junction of Cunnington Road with Andrewartha Road in a southerly direction to a point 14 metres south of that junction .

From its junction with the entrance to Tower Hill School in a north easterly direction for a distance of 9 metres.
