

SALFORD CITY COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES)
(CONSOLIDATION AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2013.

The Council of the City of Salford in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and by virtue of The Bus Lane Contraventions (Approved Local Authorities) (England) (Amendment) and Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions Designation (No.2) Order 2012, (Statutory Instrument No.2659) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the County of Greater Manchester in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

INTERPRETATION

1. In this Order:-

(1) "the Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"chargeable hours" means the hours specified in Column 3 of Schedule 3 to this Order;

"the Council" means the Council of the City of Salford;

"civil enforcement officer" has the same meaning as in Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"collecting" and "delivering" in relation to any goods includes `checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle lawfully displaying a disabled person's badge being a vehicle which, immediately before or after any period of waiting allowed by virtue of a provision of a kind required by the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 to be included in an order under the Act, has been or is to be used for carrying disabled persons as passengers;

"driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in off street parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the said parking place;

"parking bay" means a space in the parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of the Order;

“parking charge” means the amounts specified in Column 5 of Schedule 3 to this Order in relation to the parking place specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3 to this Order;

‘parking disc’ means a disc, issued by a local authority, 125 millimetres square, coloured blue and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins, which has not ceased to be valid;

“parking period” in relation to the parking place specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3 to this Order means the period of time specified in Column 4 of Schedule 3 to this Order which corresponds to the amount of parking charge set out in Column 5 of Schedule 3 to this Order;

“parking permit” means a parking permit issued by the Council on such terms and conditions as it may determine providing an entitlement to use of the parking place;

“parking place” means the area of land authorised and described as the parking place in Schedule 2 to this Order;

“parking ticket” means a ticket issued by a parking ticket meter pursuant to this Order and indicating the payment of a parking charge and the time when the parking period expires;

“parking ticket meter” means an apparatus designed to display the time externally, to accept payment by drivers and to issue parking tickets indicating the payment of a parking charge and the date and parking period in respect of which it has been paid;

“permit holder” means the person to whom a parking permit has been issued under the provisions of this Order;

“penalty charge notice” means a notice issued and/or served in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 9 or 10 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007

“registered keeper” is the person for the time being registered with the Driving and Vehicle Licensing Agency as the person recorded as keeping the vehicle and the person named on the Vehicle Registration Document. The registered keeper is not necessarily either the legal owner of the vehicle or the driver or user of the vehicle for the time being;

“relevant position” in relation to a parking ticket or parking permit means the front or nearside of the vehicle so that all particulars on the parking ticket or parking permit are readily visible from outside the vehicle;

“staff parking permit” means a parking permit issued by the Council to an employee of the Council on such terms and conditions as it may determine providing an entitlement to use of the parking place;

“staff permit holder” means an employee of the Council to whom a staff parking permit has been issued under the provisions of this Order;

“vehicle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle constructed or adapted to carry not more than seven passengers exclusive of the driver, or any other vehicle the weight of which unladen does not exceed 3.5 tonnes.

(2) For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying: -

(a) a disabled person’s badge in the relevant position if: -

- (i) the badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
- (ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position of the vehicle

so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle;

(b) a parking disc is in the relevant position if: -

- (i) the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
- (ii) where the vehicle does not have a dashboard or fascia, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that when marked to show the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.

(3) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

REVOCATION OF EXISTING ORDERS

2. The Orders Specified in Schedule 1 to this Order are revoked in their entirety

DESIGNATION OF PARKING PLACES

3. (1) No person shall, except upon the direction or permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the parking places specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order unless that vehicle is displaying in the relevant position;-
- (a) a valid parking ticket issued by a parking ticket meter in accordance with Article 19 of this Order; or
 - (b) a valid parking permit issued by the Council for use in that parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order; or
 - (c) a valid Salford City Council staff parking permit issued in accordance with the provisions of this Order; or
 - (d) the vehicle is displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge in accordance with the provisions of this Order.
- (2) The number of parking bays in the parking places referred to in Column 1 of Schedule 2 and Schedule 5 to this Order for use by disabled persons vehicles only shall not exceed the number specified in Column 4 of Schedule 2 and Column 5 of Schedule 5 to this Order.
- (3) The number of bays referred to in Article 3(2) of this Order shall be determined by the Council

CAR PARKS FOR SALFORD STAFF PARKING PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY

4. (1) The parking places specified in Column 1 of Schedule 5 to this Order are authorised to be used as a parking place for vehicles displaying a staff parking permit only, during such days and such hours as specified in Columns 2 and 3 of Schedule 5 to this Order.
- (2) The driver of the vehicle is only entitled to use the parking place specified in Column 1 of Schedule 5 to this Order if that vehicle is displaying in the relevant position a valid Salford City Council staff parking permit in accordance with the provisions of this Order and in relation to any bay within the parking place which is marked in accordance with Article 13 of this Order the vehicle is also displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge in accordance with the provisions of this Order

VEHICLES WHICH MAY USE PARKING PLACES

5. The parking places specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order for leaving of vehicles of such class as specified in Column 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order.

**LAYING OUT AND MARKING OF PARKING PLACES
AND PARKING BAYS**

6. The limits of every parking bay in the parking places shall be indicated in such a manner as the Council may determine by lines, studs or other indications.

RESTRICTIONS OF USE OF PARKING PLACES

7. No person shall, except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf, drive or permit to be driven any vehicle in the parking place for any purpose other than the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place.
8. No person shall use any vehicle while it is in the parking place in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for sale or hire of his skill or services.
9. No person shall, wash, clean or overhaul any vehicle or execute any mechanical or other alterations or repairs to the vehicle while it is in the parking place except such repairs as may be essential for the purpose of enabling the vehicle to be towed or driven away from the parking place.
10. No person shall use any part of the parking place or any vehicle left in the parking place for sleeping, camping or cooking.
11. The driver of a vehicle using the parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or depart from the parking place.
12. The driver of a vehicle using the parking place shall not sound the horn or similar instrument except for the avoidance of danger when about to change the position of a vehicle in or departing from the parking place.
13. Where, within the parking place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a disabled person's vehicle the driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle to wait in the parking bay unless it is a disabled person's vehicle which is carrying the disabled person and which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge.
14. Where, within the parking place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for vehicles displaying a valid parking permit the driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle to wait in the parking bay unless it displays in the relevant position a valid parking permit.

15. Where in the parking place signs have been erected or surface markings laid out for the purpose of indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place or indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place no person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance, leaves the parking place otherwise by an exit or proceeds in a direction contrary to that specified.
16. Where at or near the entrance to the parking place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that the parking place is available only to vehicles under a specified height, width, length or weight or only at certain times no person shall cause or permit to enter the parking place any vehicle which exceeds that height, width, length or weight or outside those times.

AMOUNT OF PARKING CHARGE AT PARKING PLACES

17. The parking charge for a vehicle left in the parking place during the chargeable hours shall be in accordance with the parking charges specified in Column 5 of Schedule 3 to this Order for the parking period specified in Column 4 of Schedule 3 to this Order.

PAYMENT OF PARKING CHARGE

18. (1) Save as provided in Article 22 of this Order no person shall leave any vehicle in the parking place specified in Schedule 2 to this Order without having paid the parking charge in respect of the parking period for which the vehicle has been left and without having displayed a parking ticket issued by a parking ticket meter in accordance with Article 19 of this Order.

PROVIDED that for the purposes of this Article if a vehicle when first placed in a parking place is exempt from payment of any charge by virtue of the provisions of Article 22 of this Order and continues to wait in that parking place otherwise than in accordance with those provisions the parking charge shall be treated as having been incurred and to be payable at the time when the vehicle ceased to wait by virtue of those provisions and all the provisions of this Order shall then apply accordingly

- (2) Any vehicle having parked in a parking place, which does not incur a charge, shall not be permitted to return within a 24 hour period without being subject to the charge applicable to vehicles left for 30 minutes or more

DISPLAY OF TICKET ISSUED BY PARKING TICKET METER

19.(1) Subject to Articles 22 and 54 of this Order the parking charge shall be payable on the leaving of the vehicle in the parking place specified in Schedule 2 to this Order by: -

- (i) pressing the appropriate button to obtain a free ticket when parking for a period of less than 30 minutes; or
- (ii) the insertion in a ticket parking meter of any combination of coins or notes of denominations specified on the ticket parking meter together making up the amount of the parking charge for the parking period for which payment is being made and where more than one coin is required for the payment of that charge the coins shall be inserted in the ticket parking meter one immediately after the other; or
- (iii) by the insertion in a ticket parking meter of an approved credit or debit card and making a payment up to the amount of the parking charge for the parking period for which payment is being made in accordance with the instructions set out either on screen or on the ticket parking meter

and the parking period paid for shall not exceed the period specified in Article 17 of this Order.

- (2) Except as provided in Article 22 of this Order where the vehicle has been left in the parking place specified in Schedule 2 to this Order for the parking period of less than 30 minutes the driver of the vehicle shall cause to be displayed on the vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (4) of this Article, a parking ticket issued by a ticket parking meter indicating the day and time when the parking period will expire.
- (3) Where payment of the parking charge for a vehicle left in the parking place specified in Schedule 2 to this Order has been made in accordance with the provisions of Article 18 of this Order the driver thereof shall display or cause to be displayed on the inside of the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (4) of this Article the parking ticket issued by the parking meter on payment of the parking charge.
- (4) The parking ticket referred to in Article 18 of this Order shall be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued at all times during which the vehicle is left during the chargeable hours in the parking place on the front or nearside of the vehicle so that all the particulars on that side of the parking ticket which bears the indication that a parking charge has been paid are readily visible from the front or nearside of the vehicle.

- (5) No vehicle which has been left in accordance with Article 18(1) of this Order upon leaving the parking place during the chargeable hours shall until the expiration of one hour from the time it was taken away be left in that parking place.

INDICATIONS OF PAYMENT OF PARKING CHARGE

20. (1) Payment of the parking charge for a vehicle left in the parking place specified in Schedule 2 to this Order has been made in accordance with the provisions of Article 18 of this Order shall be indicated by the issue by a ticket parking meter of a parking ticket indicating that a parking charge has been paid and the day and time by which the parking period for which payment was made by the parking charge will expire and by the display of the parking ticket in the manner specified in Article 19 of this Order.
- (2) Where the parking ticket indicates the day and time of expiry of the parking ticket the period for which the parking charge has been paid shall be deemed to have expired when the time shown on the clock on the ticket parking meter which issued the parking ticket is later than the time shown on the ticket.
- (3) Where the parking ticket indicates the day and time of payment the period for which the parking charge has been paid shall be deemed to have expired when the time shown on the clock on the ticket parking meter which issued the parking ticket exceeds the time of payment including the time paid for.

INDICATIONS OF PAYMENT OF PARKING CHARGE AS EVIDENCE

21. (1) If at any time while a vehicle is left in the parking place specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order during the chargeable hours and no parking ticket issued by a ticket parking meter is displayed on that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 19 (4) of this Order it shall be presumed unless the contrary is proved that the parking charge has not been duly paid.
- (2) If at any time while a vehicle is left in the parking place specified in Schedule 2 to this Order during the chargeable hours the parking ticket issued by a ticket parking meter and displayed on the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 19(4) of this Order and the clock on the ticket parking meter by which such parking ticket was issued gives the indication mentioned in Article 20(2) and 20(3) of this Order it shall be presumed unless the contrary is proved that the parking charge has been duly paid in respect of that vehicle and that the parking period for which payment was made by the parking charge has already expired.
- (3) Any parking ticket issued by a ticket parking meter relating to the parking place specified in Schedule 2 to this Order shall be presumed

unless the contrary is proved to have been issued on the day shown thereon.

EXEMPTIONS FROM PARKING CHARGE

22. (1) Any disabled person's vehicle left in a parking bay which is marked in accordance with Article 13 of this Order which displays in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge shall be exempt from the parking charge.
- (2) Without prejudice to paragraph (1) of this Article a disabled person's vehicle to which paragraph (1) applies shall use the parking place in accordance with all other provisions of this Order;
- (3) Any vehicle left in a parking place specified in Column 1 of Schedule 4 to this Order, which displays in the relevant position a parking permit issued by the Council for use in that parking place shall be exempt from the parking charge.

MANNER OF STANDING IN A PARKING PLACE

23. Any vehicle left in the parking place shall so stand that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking bay, provided that in the case of any parking place where the length of any vehicle precludes it from standing wholly within the limits of a parking bay, that vehicle shall so stand in the parking bay that as much of the vehicle as possible is within the limits of the parking bay and that such portion as is beyond the limits of the parking bay and does not constitute a danger or obstruction to other users of the parking place.

ALTERATION OF POSITION OF VEHICLE IN PARKING PLACES

24. Where any vehicle is standing in the parking place in contravention of the provisions of Article 23 of this Order any person authorised by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions and may recover any expenses associated with this alteration.

REMOVAL OF VEHICLES FROM PARKING PLACES

25. Where any person authorised by the Council is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in the parking place, he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the parking place and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle. Any expenses incurred by the Council in removing a vehicle from any parking place shall be recoverable by the Council from the owner of the vehicle.

26. The Council may as respects to a vehicle which has been removed from the parking place in pursuance of Article 25 of this Order, if it appears to them to have been abandoned, sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle after having made reasonable enquiries to ascertain the name and address of the owner of the vehicle in accordance with the procedure set out in the Refuse Disposal (Amenity) Act 1978.
27. Any person removing the vehicle or altering its position by virtue of Articles 24 and 25 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.

APPLICATION AND ISSUE OF PARKING PERMITS

28. The Council may issue a parking permit to allow a vehicle to wait within the parking places specified in Column 1 of Schedule 4 to this Order, during the days and hours as specified in Column 2 and 3 of Schedule 4 to this Order, to an applicant upon payment of the appropriate charge being made to the Council
29. For the purpose of Article 28 to this Order the appropriate charge in relation to a parking permit means the payment specified in Column 3 of Schedule 4 to this Order for the parking place specified in Column 1 of Schedule 4 to this Order.
30. Should a parking permit be lost, damaged or defaced the Council may, subject to any charge it considers appropriate, issue a duplicate parking permit.

FORM OF PARKING PERMITS

31. A parking permit issued under the provisions of this Order shall be in writing and shall include the following particulars:-
 - (i) the period during which the parking permit has been granted and/or the date on which the parking permit is due to expire;
 - (ii) an authentication that the parking permit has been issued by the Council;
 - (iii) an indication of the number and/or location of the parking place to which the parking permit relates.

DUPLICATE PARKING PERMITS

32. If a parking permit issued under the provisions of this Order is mutilated or defaced or the figures or particulars on it have become illegible or the colour of the parking permit has become altered by fading or otherwise, the permit holder shall surrender it to the Council and may then apply to the Council for the issue to him of a duplicate parking permit.

33. If a parking permit is lost or destroyed, the permit holder may apply to the Council for the issue to him of a duplicate parking permit.
34. Any duplicate parking permit issued under the provisions of Articles 32 and 33 of this Order shall be marked as a duplicate, and upon the issue of a duplicate parking permit the original parking permit which it duplicates shall become invalid.
35. The provisions of this Order relating to the application for parking permits and parking permits generally shall apply to the application for duplicate parking permits and duplicate parking permits generally.

TERMINATION OF PARKING PERMITS

36. A parking permit issued under the provisions of this Order shall terminate and cease to be valid:-
 - (i) immediately upon surrender of such permit to the Council;
 - (ii) immediately without notice upon the expiry of the period specified in such permit; or
 - (iii) on a date specified in a notice addressed to the holder of the parking permit revoking the parking permit on the grounds that any or all of the matters as to which the Council was satisfied when granting the parking permit is or are no longer satisfied or for any other reason whatsoever.
37. Any notice addressed to the holder of the parking permit under the provisions of Article 36 of this Order shall be sufficiently served if addressed to that person and delivered to him personally or sent by ordinary post to his last known residence or place of business.

APPLICATION AND ISSUE OF SALFORD STAFF PARKING PERMITS

38. The Council or any person duly authorised by the Council may issue a staff parking permit to allow a vehicle to wait in the parking places specified in Column 1 of Schedule 5 to this Order during the days and hours as specified in Column 2 and 3 of Schedule 5 to this Order to any person who satisfies the Council that he is an employee of Salford City Council.
39. The Council upon being satisfied that the conditions set out in Article 38 of this Order are met and payment of the appropriate charge specified in Article 40 and Column 4 of Schedule 5 to this Order being made to the Council may issue to an employee of Salford City Council a staff parking permit.
40. For the purpose of Article 39 of this Order the appropriate charge in relation to a Salford City Council staff parking permit is;

- (i) for an employee of Salford City Council staff this means a 1% deduction to the employees gross monthly pay.
 - (ii) for an employee of Salford City Council staff who holds a valid disabled person's badge this means a 0.5% deduction to the employees gross monthly pay.
41. Should a Salford City Council staff parking permit be lost, damaged or defaced the Council may, subject to any charge it considers appropriate, issue a duplicate Salford City Council staff parking permit.

TERMINATION OF STAFF PARKING PERMITS

42. Any staff parking permit issued under the provisions of this Order shall terminate and cease to be valid:-
- (a) immediately upon surrender of such staff parking permit to the Council; or
 - (b) immediately without notice upon the expiry of the period specified on the staff parking permit; or
 - (c) on a date specified in a notice addressed to the staff parking permit holder revoking the staff parking permit on the grounds that any or all of the matters as to which the Council was satisfied when granting the staff parking permit is or are no longer satisfied or for any other reason whatsoever; or
 - (d) On a date specified in a notice addressed to the Council from the staff parking permit holder giving at least one month's written notice of the staff parking permit holder's intention to opt out of the scheme.
43. Any notice addressed to the staff parking permit holder under the provisions of Article 42 of this Order shall be sufficiently served if addressed to that person and delivered to him personally or sent by ordinary post to his last known residence or place of business.

DISPLAY OF PARKING PERMITS AND STAFF PARKING PERMITS

44. Any parking permit or staff parking permit issued under the provisions of this Order shall be displayed:-
- (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen on the nearside thereon and immediately behind the windscreen and with its front facing forward so that it is visible from outside the vehicle; or

- (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.

REMOVAL OF PARKING PERMITS AND STAFF PARKING PERMITS

- 45. Where any parking permit or staff parking permit has been displayed on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this Order no person shall remove such permit from display on such vehicle unless expressly authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle.

EVIDENTIAL MATTERS – PARKING PERMITS/STAFF PARKING PERMITS

- 46. The absence of a valid parking permit or staff parking permit on a vehicle in respect of the parking place at which the vehicle was left shall be treated as evidence that no parking permit or staff parking permit was held by the driver to park in that parking place.
- 47. An indication on a parking permit or staff parking permit as to the location of a parking place or places shall be treated as evidence of the location of the parking place or places in respect of which the parking permit or staff parking permit is valid.
- 48. An indication on a parking permit or staff parking permit of any date, month and/or year shall be treated as evidence of the date, month and/or year on which the parking permit or staff parking permit ceases to be valid.
- 49. An indication on a parking permit or staff parking permit as to a vehicle registration mark shall be treated as evidence of the vehicle in respect of which the parking permit or staff parking permit applies.

AMOUNT OF PENALTY CHARGE AT PARKING PLACES

- 50. If a vehicle is left in any of the designated off-street parking places specified in the Schedules to this Order in contravention of the provisions of this Order, or is not parked wholly within a marked parking bay, a penalty charge as advertised on site shall be payable.
- 51. In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge may have been incurred, it shall be the duty of the civil enforcement officer to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice which shall include the following particulars:
 - (a) the registration mark of the vehicle or, where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the number of the trade plate carried by the vehicle;
 - (b) the time at which the civil enforcement officer first observed the vehicle parked in contravention of the Order;

- (c) the grounds on which the civil enforcement officer believes that a penalty charge notice is payable;
- (d) the amount of the penalty charge which is payable;
- (e) that the penalty charge must be paid before the end of 28 days beginning with the date of the notice;
- (f) that if the penalty charge is paid before the end of the period of 14 days beginning with the date of the notice, the amount of the penalty charge will be reduced by the specified amount;
- (g) that if the penalty charge is not paid before the end of the 28 day period, a notice to the owner may be served by the Council on the person appearing to the owner of the vehicle;
- (h) the address to which the payment of the penalty charge must be sent.

REMOVAL OF NOTICES

52. Where a notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with any of the foregoing provisions of this Order, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle or a Civil Enforcement Officer, shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE DRIVER

53. The person who was driving the vehicle at the time when it was left in the parking place shall be responsible for complying with the provisions of all relevant Articles of this Order and unless proved to the contrary the registered keeper of the vehicle shall be deemed to be the driver of that vehicle.

POWER TO SUSPEND PARKING PLACES

54. (1) Any person authorised by the Council may, subject to such conditions or exceptions as he considers appropriate, suspend the use of the parking places or any part thereof whenever such suspension is considered reasonably necessary.
- (2) Any person suspending the use of the parking places or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of the preceding paragraph shall place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to any part of the parking place the use of which has been suspended a sign to indicate that the parking place or any part thereof is suspended.
- (3) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any part of the parking place which has been suspended in accordance with the provisions of this Article except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council.

DISCLAIMER

55. The Council shall not be held liable for any damages to loss of or theft from any vehicle in any parking place.

COMMENCEMENT

56. This Order shall come into operation on 2 December 2013 and may be cited as the Salford City Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Consolidation and Revocation) Order 2013.
