**THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF SANDWELL (VICTORIA STREET &  
GREAT WESTERN STREET WEDNESBURY)  
(WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ONE-WAY & SEGREGATED TWO-WAY  
CYCLE LANE) ORDER 2022**

The Borough Council of Sandwell in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 32 and part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with the provisions of part III of schedule 9 to the said act of 1984 hereby makes the following order:

1. This order may be cited as The Borough Council of Sandwell (Victoria Street & Great Western Street Wednesbury) (Waiting Restrictions, One-Way & Segregated Two-Way Cycle Lane) Order 2022 and shall come into operation on 16<sup>th</sup> January 2023.

2. In this order:-

- a) "Authorised person" means an employee or agent of the council authorised to exercise all or any of the functions of the council under this order.
- b) "Civil enforcement officer" means an authorised person by or on behalf of the council to enforce the restrictions in this order and issue penalty contravention notices.
- c) "Disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2013.
- d) "Driver" in relation to a motor vehicle waiting in a parking area, means the person driving the motor vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place.
- e) "Electronic communications network" has the same meaning as in section 32 of the Communications Act 2003.
- f) "Household" means the occupants of a dwelling used or suitable for use as a separate dwelling.
- g) "Junction" means the intersection of the outside edge of the first highway with the outside edge of the second highway.



- h) "Motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- i) "Parking disc" means the disc issued by the local authority complying with the requirements of regulation 8(5) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began.
- j) "Relevant position" in respect of:-
- (a) a disabled person's badge and parking disc has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000; and
- (b) a parking disc is displayed in the "relevant position" if –
- the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
  - where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle, so that, when marked to show the quarter-hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.
- k) "Universal service provider" has the same meaning given by section 65(1) of the Postal Services Act 2011.

**Victoria Street Wednesbury – one-way vehicle restriction and segregated two-way cycle lane**

3. The effect of this order is to introduce a one-way restriction for vehicles and introduce a segregated two-way cycle lane along the length of Victoria Street, Wednesbury (from Holyhead Road to Potter's Lane) as shown in hatched on drawing number 79,824 S/3 attached to this order.
4. Except as provided in clause 6 of this order, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to travel in a south westerly direction along the length of Victoria Street, Wednesbury (from its junction with Holyhead Road to its junction with Potter's Lane), as shown in orange hatching on drawing number 79,824 S/3 attached to this order.
5. Except as provided in clause 6 of this order, no person shall cause any motor vehicle to enter the segregated two-way cycle lane along the length of Victoria Street, Wednesbury (from its junction with

Holyhead Road to its junction with Potter's Lane) as shown in blue hatching on drawing number 79,824 S/3 attached to this order.

6. Clauses 4 and 5 of this order shall not apply to a vehicle when being used by the police, fire brigade or ambulance service.

**Victoria Street and Great Western Street, Wednesbury – waiting restrictions**

7. The effect of this order is to remove the existing on-street pay and display parking restrictions and introduce no waiting at any time restrictions in Victoria Street and amend the waiting restrictions in Great Western Street to no waiting at any time restrictions as shown on drawing number 79,824 S/3 attached to this order.
- 7.1. Subject to the provisions of section 7 of this order no person shall, except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait at any time in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in schedule 1 to this order.
- i) the motor vehicle is stationary; and
  - ii) a contravention shall be created if the motor vehicle remains on a length of road and it will be considered a new contravention from midnight on a rolling/daily basis.
- 7.2. Nothing in **clause 7.1** of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait as specified therein for so long as may be necessary:
- a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - b) to enable the vehicle to be used for the purposes of:-
    - i) any building operation, demolition or excavation;
    - ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
    - iv) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any electronic communications network lawfully kept installed in any position;



- v) the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in **schedule 1** of this order;
- c) to enable a vehicle, which is a universal service provider for the collection or delivery of postal packets in the course of a universal postal service;
- d) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
- e) to enable a motor vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant/civil enforcement officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.

7.3. Nothing in clause 7.1 of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a motor vehicle which displays in the relevant position, a valid disabled person's badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the motor vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the sides of lengths of road referred to in schedule 1 for a period not exceeding 3 hours (provided that this waiting is not during a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same motor vehicle in the same sides of lengths of road).

#### **Schedule 1: no waiting at any time**

<b>Column 1 Street name</b>	<b>Col 2 Side of street</b>	<b>Column 3 Location</b>
Victoria Street, Wednesbury	north-west	from its junction with Potters Lane to its junction with Holyhead Road.
Great Western Street, Wednesbury	north	from its junction with Potters Lane to a point 11 metres south-west of that junction.
Great Western Street, Wednesbury	north	from a point 42m south west its junction with Potters Lane to a point 159 metres south-west and then north-west of that junction.
Great Western Street, Wednesbury	south	from its junction with Potters Lane to a point 83 metres south-west of that junction.

#### **Great Western Street, Wednesbury - limited waiting during prescribed hours**

8. The effect of this order is to remove the existing limited waiting during prescribed hours on the south east side of Great Western Street and introduce no waiting at any time restriction, and amend the existing no waiting at any time restriction on the north west side of Great Western Street to limited waiting during prescribed hours restriction as shown on drawing number 79,824 S/3 attached to this order.
- 8.1. Subject to the provisions section 8 of this order, no person shall, except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in column 1 of schedule 2 to this order during the hours prescribed in column 4 of the said schedule:
- (a) for a period exceeding the length of time specified in **column 5 of schedule 2**;
  - (b) during any period separated by an interval of less than the duration specified in **column 6 of schedule 2** from a previous period of waiting by the same motor vehicle in the same side and length of road.
- 8.2. For the purposes of **clause 8.1**, a motor vehicle shall be taken to wait on a length of road if:
- i) the motor vehicle is stationary; and
  - ii) a contravention shall be created if a motor vehicle remains on a length of road at the beginning of a period in which vehicles may be left there and shall be treated as if it had been left there at the beginning of that period.
- 8.3. Nothing in **clause 8.1** of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait as specified therein for so long as may be necessary:
- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) to enable the vehicle to be used for the purposes of:-
    - i) any building operation, demolition or excavation;
    - ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
    - iv) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication system lawfully kept installed in any position;



- v) the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in **schedule 2** of this order;
  - (c) to enable a vehicle which is a universal service provider for the collection or delivery of postal packets in the course of a universal postal service;
  - (d) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (e) to enable a motor vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant/civil enforcement officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.
- 8.4. Nothing in **clause 8.1** of this order shall apply to a vehicle that is displaying in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge.

## **Schedule 2: limited waiting during prescribed hours**

### **Great Western Street, Wednesbury – on-street taxi rank**

9. The effect of this order is to remove the existing on-street taxi rank on the south-east side of Great Western Street and introduce no waiting at any time restriction, and amend the existing no waiting at any time restriction on the north-west side of Great Western Street to on-street taxi rank as shown on drawing number 79,824 S/3 attached to this order.
- 9.1. Subject to the provisions of section 9 of this order, no person shall, except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle other than a

taxi to wait in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in schedule 3 to this order.

- 9.2. For the purposes of **clause 9.1**, a motor vehicle shall be taken to wait on a length of road if:
- i) the motor vehicle is stationary; and
  - ii) a further contravention shall be created if the motor vehicle remains on a length of road at the beginning of a period in which vehicles may be left there in pursuance of this order and shall be treated as if it had been left there at the beginning of that period.
- 9.3. Nothing in **clause 9.1** of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle that is a taxi, to wait in the sides and lengths of roads referred to in **schedule 3** to this order.
- 9.4. Nothing in **clause 9.1** of this order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any motor vehicle to wait as specified therein for so long as may be necessary:
- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with-
    - i) any building operation, demolition or excavation;
    - ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
    - iv) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication system lawfully kept installed in any position;
    - v) the collection of household refuse from, or the cleaning of cesspools at premises situated on or near the sides and lengths of roads specified in **schedule 3** of this order;
  - (c) to enable a vehicle which is a universal service provider for the collection or delivery of postal packets in the course of a universal postal service;
  - (d) to enable a motor vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority, parking attendant/civil enforcement officers or water authority, sewage authority and national rivers authority purposes, when used in pursuance of their statutory powers or duty.

10.1 The Borough Council of Sandwell (Sandwell Borough, Consolidation of Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Traffic Regulation Order No.14) 2019 is hereby revoked in part in respect of the following items:

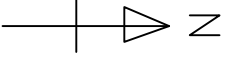
